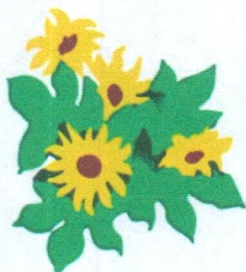

SCHOOL-BASED OPEN LANDSCAPING COMPETITION GUIDELINES

1. The Competition will be dubbed the **School-Based Open Landscaping Competition**.
2. The contest is open to all Public and Private Elementary and Secondary schools in the City of Baguio.
3. **The competition shall cover GARDENS not more than 120 sq.m but not less than 81 sq.m**
4. Only one (1) official entry may be entered per school.
5. Only schools that have accomplished the required registration form, be eligible to join the contest (details and other specifications such as location, area, and person in charge should be expressly stated).
6. Entries/gardens must be prepared before the scheduled judging dates, Judging is on February 19, 2023. Since it is a school-based landscaping contest, the judging/evaluation will **specify one (1) focal Area only as contingent and it should be sustained throughout the year**.
7. The school's entry shall be located within the school campus and must be open to the public for viewing.
8. Entries must have photos taken before, during, and after the development of the landscape for the Baguio Flower Festival, with the photos bearing a time stamp in the photo as to the date taken
9. Copies of submitted photos of the landscaping become the property of the BFFFI after the competition whether or not the entry is winning or not.
10. The judges' decision is final
11. Submission of entries should be done at the Secretariat no later than February 15, 2023.

a. The top 3 Winners will receive the following PRIZES:

1ST PLACE : 30,000.00
2ND PLACE : 20,000.00
3RD PLACE – 15,000.00

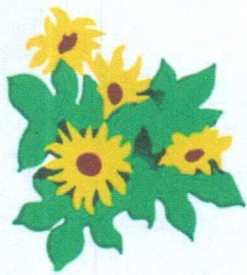

GUIDELINES

- I. **THEME: "A Renaissance of Beauty and Wonder."**
- II. **ACTIVITY: DISH GARDEN**
- III. **DATE AND TIME: February 11,2023 (Saturday) 8:30 a.m**
- IV. **VENUE: PFVR ,Upper Session Road, Baguio City**
- V. **ELIGIBILITY:**

1. This contest is open to all Public and Private Elementary (Grade 4-Grade 6).
2. Only one entry per school is allowed in each category;
3. Division Entry is limited to 20 participants only on a first come first serve basis;
4. Only schools who have accomplished the required registration form, duly received by the Schools Division of Baguio City on or before February 7-8, 2023 at 8 am- 5 Pm shall be eligible to join the contest.
5. Contestant shall bring their own materials, supply,tools, equipment, and other things needed for the contest.

VI. SPECIFIC GUIDELINES:

1. Briefing of contestants will be done 15 minutes before the scheduled event.
2. Contestant should be at the designated venue thirty minutes (30) minutes before the event
3. The event administrator shall signal for the event to begin. Once the event has started. The coaches/teachers are no longer allowed to talk to the participant/s.
4. Only the event organizers, technical committee members, judges, official photographers, and contestants are allowed in the venue.
5. Borrowing of and tools, materials, supplies are not allowed.
6. A blueprint or a sketch or plan must be submitted by the contestant in long sized bond paper
7. The dish garden shall remain untouched until the closing ceremony
8. The contestant shall go through a panel interview and deliberation after the 4-hour time allotment.
9. The working area should be cleaned immediately after every event.
10. All outputs should be endorsed to the secretariat and shall be displayed until the duration of the event.

11. CRITERIA FOR JUDGING:

a. Visual Impact	20%
b. Originality of sketch plan	10%
c. Combination and design of plants and materials (principles in landscaping)	20%
d. Use of tools and equipment	10%
e. Methods and Safety work habit	10%
f. Followed Sketch plan	10%
g. Speed	10%
h. Ability to perform the process	10%

- IV. **VENUE:** PFVR, Upper Session Road, Baguio City
- V. **ELIGIBILITY:**

1. This competition is open to all Public and Private High School Students (Junior and Senior High School).
2. Only one entry per school is allowed in each category;
3. Division Entry is limited to 20 participants only on a first-come, first-served basis;
4. Only schools who have accomplished the required registration form, duly received by the Schools Division of Baguio City on or before February 7-8, 2023 at 8 am- 5 Pm shall be eligible to join the contest.

VI. SPECIFIC GUIDELINES:

1. All participants have to set up and display a Center Piece Hotel Lobby Fresh Flower Arrangement in one (1) hour and thirty (30) minutes following the theme.
2. The Red and White Fresh Flower Arrangement shall be displayed as a centerpiece on a rectangular table good for 12 pax.
3. All materials for this competition must be provided by the participants. These materials shall be incorporated in the design, either as an accent, featured, or focal point materials taking into consideration the theme of the category.
4. Correctness, proper use of materials, and creative presentation will have a great impact on scores.
5. Height of the art should not be more than 24" and not less than 20" in width
6. The chairperson will brief the participants an hour before the competition.

7. CRITERIA FOR JUDGING:

a. Visual Impact	20%
b. Artistic merit and creativity	35%
c. Relevance to the theme	25%
d. Balance and harmony	20%

8. Judge's decision shall be final and non-appealable.
