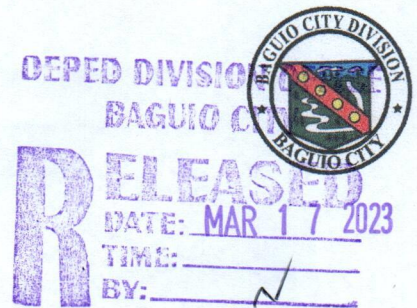

1. Our Baguio City Little League Junior Baseball Team one of the top 2 teams in Luzon during the conduct of 2023 Little League Philippines Series qualifiers in the division of Junior League Baseball held in City of Ilagan, Isabela last February 5-12, 2023.

In line with the upcoming **LITTLE LEAGUE PHILIPPINES SERIES NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP 2023**, this office is informing the field that Baguio City Little League Baseball Team Advances to Philippine Series National Championship and will be held on April 7 to 17, 2023 at Ilagan City Isabela. The opening ceremonies will be on April 8, 2023 at Ilagan City Sports Complex.
3. This tournament is the largest baseball and softball tournament in the country today with over 1,500 boys and girls from ages 8-16 competing for the right to represent the country in the Asia-Pacific Regional Tournament to be held on July 2023 at Korea.
