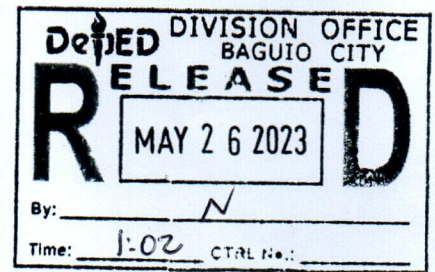

2023 COUNCIL SCOUT JAMBOREE

1. We are pleased to announce the holding of the **2023 COUNCIL SCOUT JAMBOREE** of the **Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSOP)**, Baguio City Council on **June 09 - 12, 2023** at **Farmville Campsite and Resort, Barangay Sta. Cecilia, Aringay, La Union**.
2. The Scouting event will be a good opportunity to enhance learning through the different activities and experience Scout brotherhood and sisterhood.
3. The Jamboree theme is “ **Sustaining Relevance and Strengthening Resilience through Youth Engagement** ”.
4. The Jamboree aims to:
 - a. Promote the ability of young people to do useful things for themselves and others;
 - b. Train young people in Emergency Preparedness which includes the basics of Safety & First-Aid, Scout skills, Archery, Taekwondo, Orienteering, Tree Planting., Scouts Go Solar, River Crossing and competitive activities.
 - c. Inculcate patriotism, civic consciousness and responsibility, self-reliance, discipline and kindred virtues through the Scout Method
 - d. Accomplish the requirements for selected Merit Badges and Scout ranks under the revised Advancement Scheme and Merit Badge System.
5. Following are the details:
 - 5.1. **Participation requirements:**

For Scouts

- Currently registered Boy/Senior/Rover Scouts
- Must be at least 9 to 12 years old for Boy Scouts
- Must be at least 13 to 18 years old for Senior Scouts
- Must be physically fit as certified by a Physician
- Must have Parent's/Guardian's Consent
- Equipped with adequate camping gears and equipment

For Adult Leaders

- Must be of good character
- Currently registered as Troop Leader or Outfit Adviser
- Must have served as Unit Leader/Assistant for at least two (2) years
- Must be physically fit as certified by a physician
- Equipped with adequate camping gears and equipment

- 5.2. **Jamboree Fee:** A registration fee of **FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (Php 500.00)** shall be charged from each camper (*Scouts & Adults*) to cover the cost of t-shirt, program materials, identification & activity cards, certificate of participation, administrative requirements and entrance fee (Farmville Campsite and Resort).

Note: A non-refundable but transferrable reservation fee of **Three Hundred Pesos (Php 300.00)** must be remitted to the BSP Baguio City Council Office on or before **June 02, 2023** to ensure participation.

6. Other details of the Jamboree are:

- a. Contingents will bring their own cooking equipments and must arrange their own transportation from point of origin to the Jamboree site drop-off point and return.

Districts/Schools must organize their contingents which shall be sub-divided into Patrols/Crews and Troops/Outfits.


Sub-Camps: Contingents must set up their camp only in their designated Sub-Camp.

Sub-Camp activities, orderliness, cleanliness and discipline shall be under the direct supervision of the Sub-Camp Directors.

Only duly registered campers with proper identification cards will be allowed to enter the camp and participate in the activities.

Participants are also advised to bring scissors, 1 used plastic bottle (soft drinks) for the Tide Turner Plastic Challenge and working clothes/caps for Archery and instruments/props for the Scouts Got Talent (Banda Rito, Banda Roon (materials for the band are kitchen wares like spoons, cups, galloons, plates and others), Talents Unlimited and Cultural Presentation.

7. All Scouting Districts are therefore enjoined to give everyone all possible opportunities to experience attending the Scout Jamboree.
