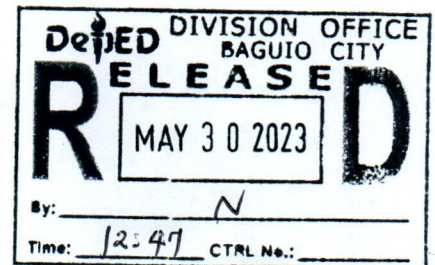



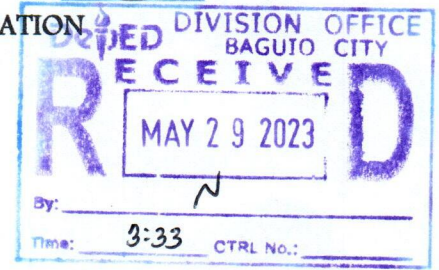

The objectives of the training and conference are as follows:


