10. The poster must illustrate, interpret and emphasize the theme *“People first: stop stigma and discrimination, strengthen prevention”*
11. The poster will be judged according to the following criteria
 - RELEVANCE TO THE THEME- 30%
 - ORIGINALITY- 25%
 - CREATIVITY- 20%
 - COLOR HARMONY AND VISUAL IMPACT- 15%
 - OVER-ALL IMPACT- 10%
 - OVERALL TOTAL – 100 %
