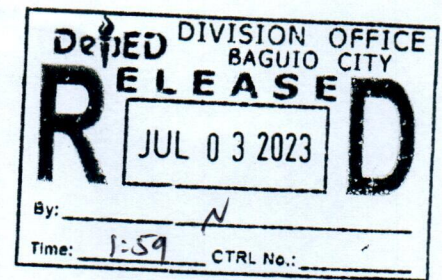

NATIONAL DISASTER RESILIENCE MONTH (NDRM) CELEBRATION

1. Pursuant to Executive Order 29 signed in 2017, July is celebrated yearly as National Disaster Resilience Month (NDRM). This event aims to highlight the importance of understanding disaster risks, strengthening disaster risk governance, investing in disaster risk reduction for resilience, enhancing preparedness for effective response, and recovering from the effects of hazards and disasters through effective risk management. This year's NDRM theme is "BIDAng Pilipino: Building a Stronger Filipino Well-Being Towards Disaster Resilience"
2. In line with the said celebration, the Schools Governance and Operations Division in partnership with City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO) will be conducting a roadshow at Malcolm Square on **29 July 2023 (9:00AM)**. All schools are encouraged to send **three (3) student leaders and one teacher** to participate in the roadshow. Snacks will be served at the venue.
3. There will also be an on-the-spot poster-making for high school students during the roadshow. All materials that will be used for the poster-making will be shouldered by the CDRRMO. Please see Enclosure 1 for the detailed guidelines of the poster-making contest.
4. Likewise, all schools are requested to conduct relevant activities in celebration of the NDRM Month.

NATIONAL DISASTER RESILIENCE POSTER MAKING CONTEST MECHANICS

I. QUALIFICATIONS

- Open to all Filipino Students, Grades 7 to 12 School Year 2022-2023.
- Family members and relatives of CDRRMO and OCD CAR staff of affinity (related to spouse) or consanguinity is eligible to join.

II. MECHANICS

- Submission of entries is from 03 to 26 July 2023 to SGOD-DRRM through Mr. Jimmy S. Santos, Project Development Officer.
- The participants must fill up the entry form attached in this mechanics. Participants must also submit an initial entry for them to be qualified. The initial entry may be drawn in a short bond paper.
- Poster design must be original and not previously published or won in any contest.
- It must reflect the general theme of NDRM which is *BIDAng Pilipino: Building a Stronger Filipino Well-Being Towards Disaster Resilience*
- It must promote gender-sensitivity, social inclusivity and must not bear obscene, pornographic, offensive content in any way.
- It must be drawn in a ½ illustration board (30" X 20") using portrait orientation.
- Participants may use any of the following art medium: crayons, oil pastel, colored pencil, colored markers, oil paint, and poster color.
- Every entry submitted to the contest belongs to the contestants who originally created it until that entry is selected as the winner. The winning entries will be owned by the CDRRMO Baguio City as part of its Information, Education and Communication (IEC) materials.

III. ON-THE-SPOT CONTEST

- All participants will compete on-the-spot using the NDRM theme on 29 July 2023 at Malcolm Square, Baguio City
- Participants will be given two hours to draw their poster.
- Only the following materials will be used:
 - ½ illustration board (30" X 20") portrait orientation
 - Any of the following art medium: crayons, oil pastel, colored pencils, colored markers, oil paint, and poster color
- Entries will be judged after the contest proper. Awarding will be conducted during the culminating activity for the NDRM 2023.
