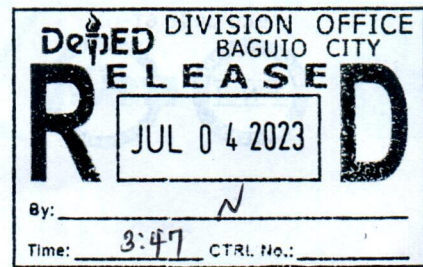



**PARTICIPATION TO THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION-CAR
