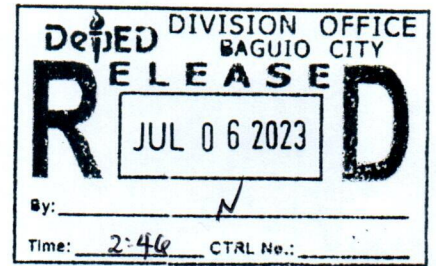



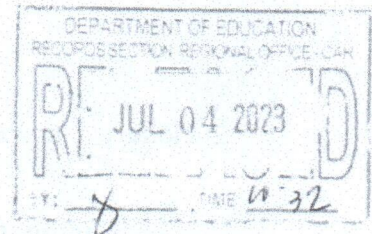

2. This activity aims to provide teaching and non-teaching personnel with opportunities to showcase their talents and skills on the following contest areas:



- a. Cordillera March Singing Competition

GUIDELINES and CRITERIA

A. Singing Competition

1. There shall be one (1) entry per SDO.
2. The participants are teachers and non-teaching of DepEd CAR.
3. The group should be composed of 3 participants.
4. The group shall sing two songs with one (1) or more musical instruments (warm up song -any IPED Song).
5. The contest piece is the song titled, "Hail Our Home Cordillera." It will be provided by the RTWG.
6. Video Recording of the performance shall be in MP4 format and to be forwarded at **clmd@deped.gov.ph** on or before **July 24, 2023**.

<i>Technical- (evaluation includes the overall sound quality of the choir, stability of the intonation, accuracy of rhythm, width of dynamic range, corrections of harmony and proper diction)</i>	50	
<i>Artistic Merits - (evaluation includes musicality (artistic expression, interpretation, and style, tonal quality of the ensemble, balance, and blending) and programming, faithfulness to the written score, variety, difficulty, and sustainability to the capacity of the choir.</i>	50

B. Essay Writing Contest on the theme: "Celebrating One, Resilient, Diverse, and Inclusive (CORDI) Journey Toward Regional Autonomy."

1. There shall be one (1) entry per SDO.
2. The participants are teachers of DepEd CAR.
3. Entries must be written in English, encoded, double-spaced, with a minimum of 1,500 words and maximum of 3,000 words.
4. Typewritten double-spaced on A4-sized paper with one-inch margins on all sides.
5. Font type: Bookman
6. Font size: 11

7. The decision of the judges shall be final.
8. Author's name SHOULD NOT appear in the entry. Only one entry per Contestant is accepted.
9. A soft copy of the entry shall be sent at **clmd@deped.gov.ph** on or before **July 24, 2023**, in a PDF format.

Criteria	Score	Total
Content - The entry also should reflect historical perspective—the causes and consequences of an event	60%	
Relevance to the Theme –The entry must clearly relate to the theme and demonstrate why the topic is significant in history. Local history topics may not be well known but may represent larger trends or events.	20%	
Clarity of Presentation – Quality and overall appearance. Organized and logical. Properly used citations. Free of grammatical error, spelled correctly, and neatly	20%

1. There shall be one (1) entry per SDO.
2. The participants are non-teaching personnel of DepEd CAR.
3. The entry must be written in English with a minimum of 500 words and maximum of 1,000 words.
4. Typewritten double-spaced on A4-sized paper with one-inch margins on all sides.
5. Font type: Bookman
6. Font size: 11
7. Author's name SHOULD NOT appear in the entry. Only one entry per Contestant is accepted.
8. The decision of the judges shall be final.
9. A soft copy of the entry shall be sent at **clmd@deped.gov.ph** on or before **July 24, 2023**, in a PDF format.
