



In observance of the upcoming International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking of Drugs (IDADAIT) on June 2023 the City Anti Drug Abuse Council (CADAC) through the Special Services Division — City Mayor's Office will conduct a Poster Making Contest for our Elementary and Junior High School students.

In this regard, we are again seeking your assistance in disseminating the information to the different schools in the City.

The following are the mechanics of the contest:

- 1. The contest is open to all enrolled Grade 5 and 6 students for the elementary category and enrolled Grades 9 and 10 for the junior high school category
- 2. The poster must be original.
- 3. Any graphic software can be used
- 4. Orientation: Portrait
- 5. Format: JPEG File
- 6. File name: IDADAIT2023_First Name Middle Initial Surname_Grade Level School
- Only one entry per category per school shall be submitted to be judged by the board of judges (Each school is requested to conduct their pre-judgment of entries)
- 8. Three (3) winners will be declared in each category (elementary and junior high school category)
- The winners will receive the following prizes and their work shall be used in the calendars that will be distributed to barangays and stakeholders for CY 2023)

Elementary:

^{1st} prize - P 7,000.00 2nd prize - P 6,000.00 3rd prize - P 5,000.00

Junior High School:

1st prize – P 7,000.00 2nd prize – P 6,000.00 3rd prize – P 5,000.00

- 10. The poster must illustrate, interpret and emphasize the theme "People first: stop stigma and discrimination, strengthen prevention"
- 11. The poster will be judged according to the following criteria
 - RELEVANCE TO THE THEME- 30%
 - ORIGINALITY- 25%
 - CREATIVITY- 20%
 - COLOR HARMONY AND VISUAL IMPACT- 15%
 - OVER-ALL IMPACT- 10%
 - OVERALL TOTAL 100 %

- 12. Entries per school shall be pre-judged by their respective faculty. Finalists from schools shall then be judged by a Board of Judges. The decision of the panel are final and irrevocable. The judges shall be composed of the following
