1. In support of DepEd Order 42, s. 2017 on the National Adoption and Implementation of the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers and recognizing the professional standards in the continuing professional development and advancement of teachers based on principle of lifelong learning, the Curriculum Implementation Division through the Public Schools District Supervisors (Districts 4,5 and 7) will be spearheading the conduct of **"TEACHING WITH IMPACT: INSTITUTING MODERN PEDAGOGY AND CREATIVE TEACHING"** to all Master Teachers and Professional Development Coordinators of Districts 4,5 and 7 on July 25, ~~28~~ - 30, 2023, 8AM to 5PM at the SDO Baguio Training Hall.

2. This learning and development activity aims to:

- Develop concrete plan to showcase exemplary teaching strategies as well as effective and constructive behavior management skills that promote learner achievement across learning areas;
- Create an inventory of effective teaching strategies in the planning and management of developmentally sequenced teaching and learning process in varied teaching contexts for provision to teachers for career stage 1 and 2; and
- Illustrate the process of designing, adopting and implementing teaching strategies that are inclusive and responsive to learners with disabilities, giftedness and talents.

3. Participants are 60 Master Teachers and Professional Development Coordinators of Districts 4, 5 and 7 (See Enclosure no. 1). Participants are advised to contact their PSDS on or before July 24, 2023 in case they cannot attend and for them to look for their replacement in coordination with their PSDS.

4. Coordination Meeting of all TWG will be on July 19,2023 at 8 a.m. onwards at the SDO Training Hall. Expenses on the said training and meeting shall be charged against HRDT funds subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.

5. Participants need to strictly comply with protocols on social distancing and implement precautionary measures consistent with the IATF health protocols.

6. Participants shall be entitled to four days service credits as per DO No. 53, s. 2003 and CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 respectively.






