Greetings from ICLEI Southeast Asia!

Youth engagement and participation are at the heart of the Safe and Sound Cities (S<sup>2</sup>Cities) Programme. Through the S<sup>2</sup>Cities Programme, we aim to consolidate the youth's ideas, initiatives and aspiration in co-defining and co-creating a Safe and Sound Baguio. Thus, the conception of a Mobile Youth Hub.

The Baguio local grantee, Cordilleran Youth Center (CYC) is launching the Mobile Youth Hub (MYH) which will serve as an innovation incubator on wheels that will bring the S<sup>2</sup>Cities Programme closer to the youth of Baguio. It will supplement the Youth Innovation Hub provided by the City Government of Baguio through the City Planning, Development and Sustainability Office (CPDSO), located at the basement of the Baguio Convention and Cultural Center. The MYH will visit schools, communities and public spaces in the city. Moreover, shall provide a myriad of functions that primarily aims to encourage the youth in participating to the S<sup>2</sup>Cities Programme and the upcoming Youth Innovation Challenge; gather thoughts and ideas from the youth and will be a flexible hub that can offer varied activities.

The Mobile Youth Hub is a Nissan Urvan Premium van model with a portable tent extension, chair, benches, youth exhibit and a mini-reading nook. It also features interactive activities like a mobile cinema with a screen and portable projector and speakers. Additionally, interactive activities are also available in the MYH that includes art and freedom walls; interactive Baguio map, among others.

This August, CYC aims to officially roll out the **Mobile Youth Hub Caravan and Roadshow in Baguio City in 4 categories:**

1. **MYH Roadshow at Sundays in Session Road:** A public roadshow along session road during selected Sundays. It will primarily offer activities, public film showing and performances that will feature the Safe and Sound Cities program.
2. **MYH Roadshow at Baguio Parks:** Depending on the parks, it will flexibly adapt with its captive audience that include story-reading activities in Children's Park, focused group discussions at Igorot Park and Burnham Park among others, whilst other activities still be available.
3. **MYH Caravan in Barangays:** It will primarily showcase the Hub exhibit, games and a discussion/consultation among youth in the barangay on safety and urban development concerns (targeting at least 10-15 young people aged 15 to 30 years old). A separate activity design and proposed program will be shared once available.
4. **MYH Caravan in Schools:** The MYH will be parked at the heart of the most possible open field in the school and shall invite students to interact to the Hub with activities aiming to gather innovative and inspiring ideas. The Hub will be complimented with a student consultation and discussion on safety and urban development concerns that targets student councils, school organizations and publications (a target of at least 80 students in a separate indoor venue within the school). A separate activity design and proposed program will be shared once available.

For MYH Caravan in Schools, the Mobile Youth Hub requires a parking space along with its portable tent. The target dates and parking spaces for the **Mobile Youth Hub Caravan and Roadshow** are as follows:
