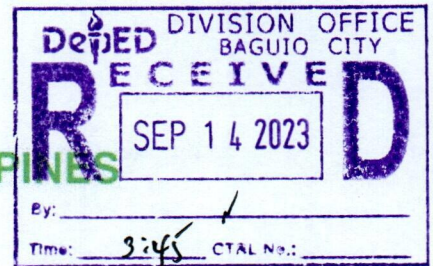

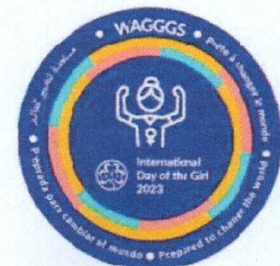

**RE : INTERNATIONAL DAY OF THE GIRL (IDG) 2023 CELEBRATION –  
“GIRL SCOUTS GOT TALENT”**

**DATE : September 13, 2023**

The United Nations declared that the International Day of the Girl (IDG) be marked every year on October 11 since 2012. The day focuses attention on the need to address the challenges girls face, promoting girls’ empowerment, and the fulfillment of their human rights.

This year, the World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts (WAGGGS) being the largest worldwide voluntary Movement dedicated to girls and young women again joins the global celebration of IDG by helping girls develop the resilience they needed to face the pressures and challenges of growing up in a changing world. Thus, WAGGGS came up with the



#PreparedToChangeTheWorld Activity Pack to showcase how girls do not have to wait until they are grown up to make change in the world – they can do great things now!

To recognize the Girl Scouts’ resilience exhibited during the COVID-19 pandemic and to celebrate IDG 2023, we are pleased to inform you that the Girl Scouts of the Philippines National Headquarters will now resume holding the **“Girl Scouts Got Talent”** on **Wednesday, October 11, 2023 from 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the Pilar Hidalgo Lim Auditorium, GSP National Headquarters, 901 Padre Faura Street, Ermita, Manila.**

Girl Scouts Got Talent aims to showcase the different modes of talent of our Girl Scouts in performing arts which may include dance, music (singing or playing musical instruments), drama, spoken word, puppetry among others that promote girl empowerment. It is also a good opportunity for our girls to express their creativity, show off their skills, and build their confidence and character.



Please be reminded that the Girl Scouts Got Talent **is not a competition, but rather a showcase of flair** where three (3) best performers will be selected to render intermission numbers during the Chief Girl Scout Medal Presentation Ceremony on Wednesday, November 15, 2023 at the Plenary Hall of the Philippine International Convention Center (PICC), CCP Complex, Pasay City.

In this regard, we invite all the Regions and Councils to encourage their girls to participate.

### The rules and regulations are:

1. It is open to all registered Five-Age Level Girl Scouts. Performers can sign up for solo, pair, or group acts. Groups can only have a maximum number of twenty (20) members.
2. Each Region can only have a maximum of five (5) solo or group performers. Each Council is allowed to have one (1) performance only.
3. Acts will be allotted at least 3 minutes and a maximum of 5 minutes to perform.
4. Presentations should be wholesome and entertaining (STRICTLY no negative, no crossdressing, no gay roles, e.g. making fun of disabilities/sexually suggestive actions, etc.).
5. Acts requiring more than 12 feet of ceiling height will not be allowed.
6. NO profanity or vulgar lyrics in any vocal performance or dance music.
7. Costumes, props, and musical accompaniment may be used to enhance the performance.
8. NO nudity allowed! Keep attire at a respectable and tasteful level. NO alcohol, tobacco, or drug advertisements are to be shown on any clothing.
9. NO pyrotechnics, open flames, or any other dangerous additions.
10. A sound technician and microphone(s) will be provided.
11. Performers MUST provide their own recorded music, instruments, props, etc., if needed.
12. Recorded music MUST be on a USB flash drive in an acceptable format (i.e. MP3 file) to be submitted to National Headquarters on or before **October 4, 2023**.
13. The **technical and dress rehearsal** of all the performers is on **October 11, 2023** from **9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.** only.
14. Lunch and afternoon snacks will be provided to all performers and to their respective two coaches/troop leaders on October 11. Lunch will be served at 11:00 a.m. at the Josefa Llanes Escoda Hall and afternoon snacks will be distributed after the event.
15. IDG 2023 and Girl Scouts Got Talent Badges as well as Certificate of Recognition will be awarded to the performers and their coaches/troop leaders.
16. Each performer/girl may invite two (2) guests/chaperones who can be her parents, siblings, or troop leader. Only the listed guests will be allowed to enter the auditorium.
17. **It is a showcase of talent and NOT a competition.**
18. Three (3) performances or groups will be selected to perform during the Chief Girl Scout Medal Presentation Ceremony on November 15, 2023 at the PICC Plenary Hall, Pasay City.
19. Participating Councils must confirm their participation by submitting the accomplished registration form to their respective region on or before **September 19, 2023**. This is on a first come first served basis. (*Attached is the registration form.*)
20. Regions will submit to National Headquarters via e-mail their list of participants together with the accomplished registration form on or before **September 25, 2023**.

On the other hand, Girl Scouts who will not participate in the Girl Scouts Got Talent can also earn their IDG 2023 Badges by accomplishing the required activities from the #PreparedToChangeTheWorld Activity Pack (see attached) and submitting narrative

reports with pictures to GSP National Headquarters c/o Program Division on or before December 1, 2023.


