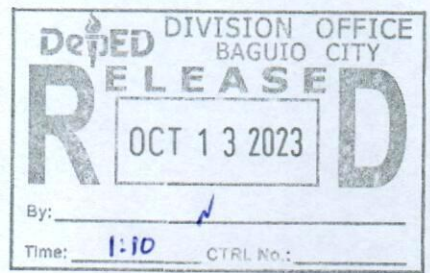

**Institutional PhilSys Step 2 Registration and ePhild Issuances  
for Baguio City Public Schools**

The Philippine Statistics Authority, as the lead implementing agency for RA No. 11055 or the Philippine Identification System (PhilSys) Act, is mandated to establish a single system for all Filipino citizens.

The aforementioned Office commits to register a cumulative number of 92 million Filipinos to PhilSys, as well as to ensure the inclusivity of the National ID System.

In this regard, this Office requests all school heads to disseminate in their respective schools the conduct of the institutional PhilSys registration for learners, school personnel including parents. School Heads are also requested to set up mobile registration sites at the school premises.

**SUBJECT:** Request to Conduct Institutional PhilSys Step 2 Registration and ePhilID Issuances for Baguio City Public Schools

Dear **Ma'am Faculo**:

Greetings,

As the lead implementing agency for Republic Act No. 11055 or the Philippine Identification System (PhilSys) Act, the PSA is mandated to establish a single identification system for all Filipino citizens.

By the end of the second quarter of 2023, we commit to register a cumulative number of 92 million Filipinos to PhilSys. As of July 14, 2023, we have already registered a total of 80 million Filipinos. This number corresponds to 87 percent of the target: Majority of these individuals are aged 15 years old and over who were registered in 2021. At the height of the Coronavirus disease (Covid) 2019 pandemic, mobility restrictions on children below 15 years old and elderly were strictly imposed.

To reach our target and ensure the inclusivity of the National ID System, we plan to conduct institutional registrations and issuance of printed ePhilIDs in schools. This strategy brings the aforementioned PhilSys services closer to the remaining unregistered population. Relative to this, may we kindly request for your approval and assistance on the implementation to set up mobile registration sites at the premises of Baguio City Public Schools to register students and parents including faculty staff.
