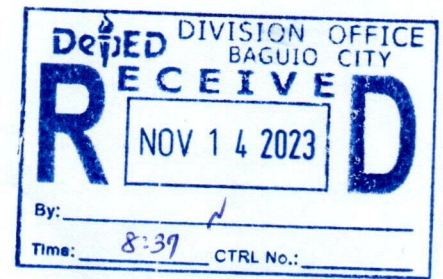

COUNCIL OFFICE MEMORANDUM

18th NATIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSOP), Baguio City Council will organize a contingent of Boy Scouts, Senior Scouts, Rover Scouts & Roverettes and Scout Leaders to the 18th National Scout Jamboree on December 11 - 17, 2023 at Passi City, Province of Iloilo.

This year's most awaited National Scout Event happens only every four (4) years and is expecting to host more than 30,000 Scouts and Leaders nationwide with some special guests, and participation from other National Scout Organization from other countries.

2. The Jamboree aims to:
 - a. Provide a progressive, exciting, challenging, safe and enjoyable learning environment for the Scouts in order to enhance their full Social, Physical, Intellectual, Character, Emotional and Spiritual potentials as an active citizen making real contribution in creating a better community;
 - b. Promote Scouting's highest quality standards of educational initiatives that is faithful to the vision, mission, fundamental principles and methods of Scouting and adapted to the needs and aspirations of young people;
 - c. Undertake high-adventure and outdoor activities that promotes active and healthy lifestyle and appreciation of nature and environment;
 - d. Conduct community service projects related to the current thrusts of World Scouting's Four (4) Thematic Areas of Education under the Scouting Education for Sustainable Development (1) Environment and Sustainability, (2) Peace and Community Engagement, (3) Skills for Life, and (4) Health and Well-Being;
 - e. Complete and satisfy the requirements for selected Merit Badges and Scout Ranks under the revised Advancement Scheme and Merit Badge System;
 - f. Acquire and develop core life skills and 21st century leadership capabilities through team building, cooperative learning, group dynamics, creative problem-solving and decision-making skills;
 - g. Increase the level of awareness and understanding about the prevailing issues on environment, human rights, mental health and well-being, education, culture and science and technology through the Global Development Village, City of Science and Cross Roads of Cultures; and
 - h. Promote Sustainable Development Goals and best practices through Modules and Educational Initiatives in Scouting.
3. Qualification for Participation:

The following are the qualifications for all participating Scouts and Adult Leaders:

/ Boy Scout and Senior Scout

- **Boy Scout and Senior Scout**

- Must be currently registered as Boy Scout or Senior Scout with a Troop or Outfit;
- Physically fit to undergo strenuous activities especially in the outdoors as certified by a licensed Physician;
- Shows leadership potentials in his/her Unit and preferably a graduate of PLTC/CLTC;
- Must be at least nine (9) to twelve (12) years old for Boy Scouts;
- Must be at least thirteen (13) to nineteen (19) years old for Senior Scouts;
- Secure his/her Parent's/Guardian's Consent; and
- Must have his/her own camping gears and equipment

- **Troop Leader and Outfit Advisor**

- Must be of good moral character;
- Must be currently registered as Troop Leader or Outfit Advisor;
- Must be Physically Fit as certified by a licensed Physician;
- Must have his/her own camping gears and equipment.

4. Registration Fee:

The Jamboree Registration Fee of **FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (Php 500.00)** shall be charged from each participant in order to defray administrative costs, program materials, souvenirs and other operating expenses.

5. Other details of the Jamboree are:


- Participants will arrange their own transportation (bus and plane) from point of origin to the Jamboree site drop-off point and return.

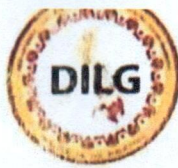


Dear Hon. Magalong:
