

The FELTA Multi-Media Inc. will hold its 13th First LEGO League (FLL) Philippines with the theme, Master Piece, at the Subic Gymnasium, Subic Freeport, Subic, Zambales on February 17, 2024.

The FLL aims to

1. support the Philippines' aggressive campaign towards the promotion of science and technology interests among the youth, particularly, in Robotics as one of the new alternative media of effective learning;
2. integrate interplay of instructivism and constructivism as an effective medium in teaching Robotics towards the discovery of promising Robotics-Scientists;
3. create and strengthen harmonious relationship and camaraderie among the participating schools, its students, and educators nationwide; and
4. offer new perspective and great opportunities in relation to the rising demands of Robotics in the local and international scene.

The activity is divided into two categories:

1. For the Master Piece theme in the FLL Explore, each school can have a maximum of six members and two coaches per level.
2. For the Master Piece theme in the FLL Challenge, each school can have a maximum of 10 members and two coaches per level.

Target participants are learners who are 6 to 10 years old for FLL Explore and 9 to 16 years old for FLL Challenge from both public and private elementary and secondary schools.

Participants of public and private schools shall be subject to the no-disruption of classes policy stipulated in DepEd Order (DO) No. 9, s. 2005 titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith and the policy on off-campus activities stated in DO 66 s. 2017. This is also subject to the no-collection policy as stated in Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546 also known as An Act Prohibiting the Sale of Tickets and/or the Collection of Contributions for Whatever Project or Purpose from Students and Teachers of Public and Private Schools, Colleges and Universities (Ganzon Law).
