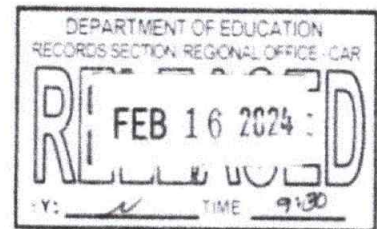

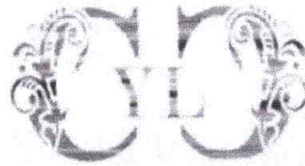

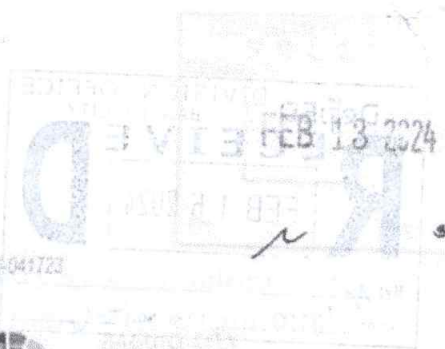

- Presentation of student researches from selected HEIs

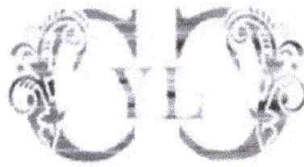
3. SDG Stakeholders Forum
