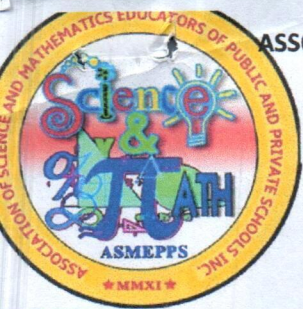
The target participants are learners from elementary and secondary schools nationwide.

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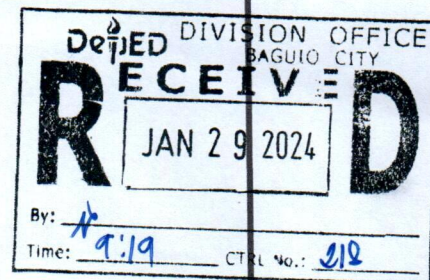

2. A Registration fee of **One Thousand Pesos** (Php1000.00) for ASMEPPS Winners and **One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos** (Php1500.00) for Item 1.2 Participants (Non ASMEPPS Winners). The fee applies to each participant per grade level and per category to cover expenses relative to the conduct of the event such as Certificates (Participation, Merit for winners, Recognition for Winning Coaches, Appreciation for Participating Schools), medals, honorarium of judges, platform provider for the quiz, ASMEPPS Kit which contains Simple Souvenir Item and Program of Activities and other incidental expenses.

### III. CONTEST MECHANICS AND CRITERIA

#### 1. Science Quiz and Math Quiz

1. Participants will be given a unique username and password to log in to GASCLOUD Technology Solutions LMS to take their respective exams.

2. Participants will use their own gadget (Cellular Phone/tablet; LAPTOP NOT allowed) to log in to GASCLOUD LMS to take the exam during the contest. The gadget should have its OWN DATA subscription.

3. Participants for the **Grade School will be given 45 minutes** to finish the entire exams. **One Hour for the High School Level.**

Participants will only have a single chance to select his/her answer in every question. No changing of answer once selected.

4. The system is set up for **1st attempt-final answer** in all questions. The system will not allow participants to change and go back to previous questions.

5. Only submitted answers to the LMS will be considered and counted.



6. Items shall be categorized as EASY, AVERAGE and DIFFICULT QUESTIONS. Each shall compose of Ten (10) items for Grade School and Fifteen (15) items for High School. One correct answer under the **Easy Level** corresponds to **1 point**; **Average Level, 2 points**; **Difficult Level, 3 points**. A total of **60 points** for the **Grade School Level** and **90 points** for **Junior and Senior High School Levels**.

7. Strictly **NO USING OF CALCULATOR** during the test. **BLANK SHEET OF PAPER** may be used for **COMPUTATION** during the **MATH Quiz**.

8. Coverage of the test. The test question will be based from the one year DepEd minimum Learning Competencies for each grade level. Additional information will be taken from current news in print or in media. For Senior High School: Science - Earth Science and Life Science; Mathematics: Basic Mathematics, Statistics and Probability.

9. Only the **LIST OF WINNERS** issued/posted by ASMEPPS are considered official results.

**FOR KINDERGARTEN:**

1. Parents should provide 3 pcs of 1/2 Bond Paper with Big Letters A, B and C written respectively. This will serve as the Show Me Board of the contestants.
2. Parents are not allowed to interfere during the examination.
3. Students may wear their school uniform or any decent clothes with their school ID .
4. There will be 15 questions to be asked. 5 questions for the easy round to be answered in 5 seconds; 5 questions for the Average round to be answered in 8 seconds and 5 questions in the Difficult round to be answered in 10 seconds.
6. The question will be read by the quizmaster twice and will give the signal for the students to raise their show me boards.
7. No changing of Answers once raised. The first Answer raised will be considered by the Board of Judges.
8. Answer of students are considered VOID in cases he/she fails to raise his/her board in the given time.
9. First Ten (10) students who get the Highest Scores will be announced as winners.
10. Non adherence to the above rules may lead to the disqualification of the contestant





## 2. Science Trivia and Math Trivia

1. Participants will be given a unique username and password to log in to GASCLOUD Technology Solutions LMS to take their respective exams.
2. Participants will use their own gadget (Cellular Phone/tablet; LAPTOP NOT allowed) to log in to GASCLOUD LMS to take the exam during the contest. The gadget should have its OWN DATA subscription.
3. Participants **will be given 60 minutes (1 Hour)** to finish the entire exams. Participants will only have a single chance to select his/her answer in every question. No changing of answer once selected.
4. The questions will be based from the Minimum Learning Competencies of each level and the next higher level categorized into WHAT, WHERE, WHEN, and WHO questions. Other questions may be taken from Basic General Info related to Math and Science Trivia.
5. Items shall be categorized as **easy, average and difficult questions**. Each of the four (4) categories shall compose of **fifteen (15) items**, a total of **sixty (60) questions**. One correct answer under the **Easy Level** corresponds to **1 point; Average Level, 2 points ; Difficult Level, 3 points**. A total of One Hundred Twenty **(120) points for both Grade School and High School Levels**.
