1. The following athletic numbers listed above per district shall be used for the 2024 Palarong Panlungsod.
2. An athlete must use two (2) pcs, with identical numbers which will be place at the front and at the back clear enough for the judges to see.
3. Each district has to produce their own numbers and safety pins needed.
4. Use red paint for secondary level and blue paint for elementary level.
5. Use white cloth which is measured 6 ½ inches by 8 ½ inches with the number clearly printed.
