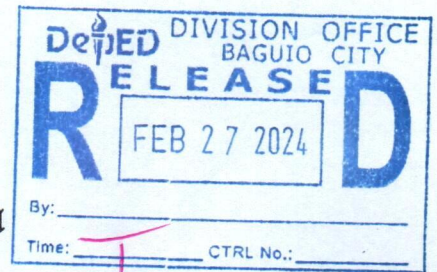

A. Mechanics:

1. The activity is open to Public Secondary Schools, one participant per school. Submission of entry form will be on a **first come, first served basis**. Maximum of 25 participants.
2. Deadline for submission of entry form is on **February 28, 2024**, from **8am-12 noon** at the SDO Baguio, CID Department c/o: Ms. Lolit Manzano or SGOD c/o _____ and _____
3. Each participant will be provided with drawing crayons (pastel, five colors including black) and drawing/illustration boards by the PSA, size 1/4.
4. All artworks must be done on the spot and must be completed within the allotted time of two hours.
5. All entries will be pre-numbered. No other identifying marks will be allowed to appear in the artworks.
6. All entries shall be judged by a three-member Board of Judges composed of two (2) DepEd Baguio selected personnel with background on the field of fine arts and one

8. The prizes shall be:

1 st Prize – 2,000 plus certificate	Champion coach: 1,000 plus certificate
2 nd Prize – 1,500 plus certificate	
3 rd Prize – 1,000 plus certificate

B. Criteria for Judging: All artworks will be judged based on the following criteria:

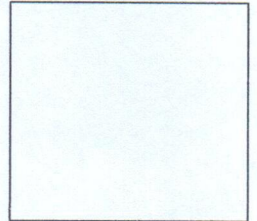

4. All Essays should be written in English and shall consist of at least 400 words and a maximum of 500 worlds,
5. All essays must be done on the spot and must be completed within the allotted time of two (2) hours.
6. All essays will automatically become official property of the PSA – RSSO CAR.
7. All entries will be pre-numbered. No distinguishing mark or name of the contestant shall appear in the entry.
8. All entries shall be judged by a three-member Board of Judges composed of two (2) DepEd selected personnel with background on the field of composition writing, and one (1) PSA Representative.

1 st Prize – Php 2,000.00 plus certificate	Champion coach: Php 1,000.00 plus certificate

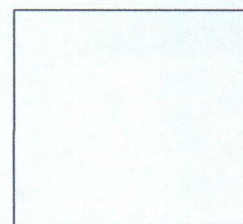

Conduct of charitable activities during the celebration is also encouraged. LCROs and PSA Field Offices may choose their target beneficiaries, which may be an institution or a community.





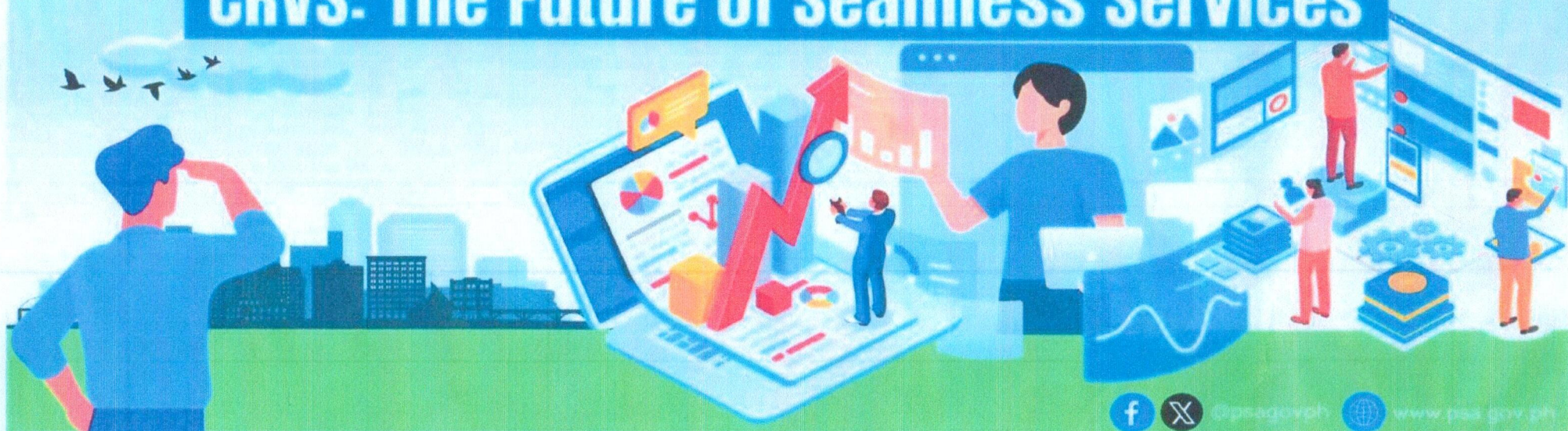

4. FREE ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATION


Free issuance of certification has always been a part of the Civil Registration Month celebration. The LCROs may issue certification to participants of the different activities as evidence of their active involvement.
