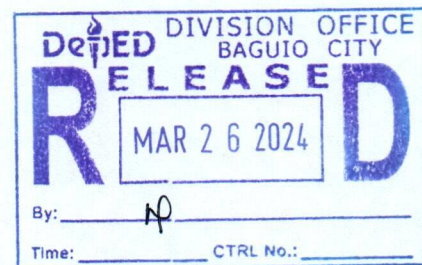


A FREE WEBINAR ON DISCOVERING THE READING ROPE

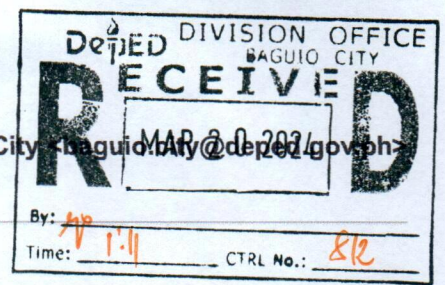

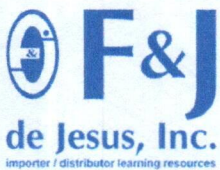

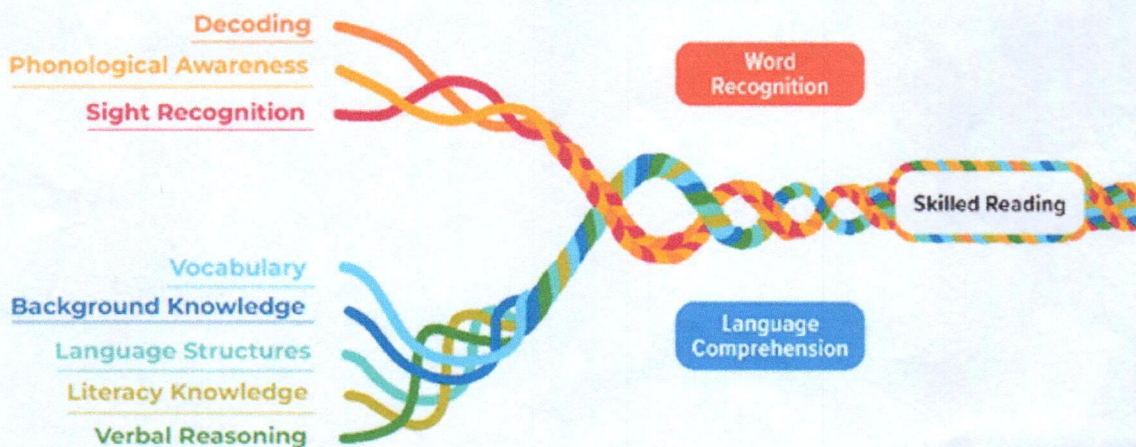
