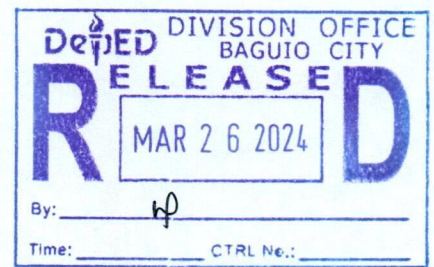

UPDATES ON THE 2024 NATIONAL LEARNING CAMP

To: CID and SGOD Chief Education Supervisors
Education Program Supervisors
Public Schools District Supervisors
School Heads/Principals
All Others Concerned

1. In preparation for the conduct of the 2024 National Learning Camp (NLC), SDO Baguio thru the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), would like to inform the field on the following updates:
 - a. Learners
 - target learners for this coming End of School Year (EOSY) break are currently enrolled in Grade 1, Grade 2, Grade 3, Grade 7, Grade 8, Grade 9 and Grade 10
 - determination of potential number of learners with the conduct of early enrolment which is scheduled from March 20 to 31, 2024 for the basis of budget allocation
 - the use of grades pending the results of the Comprehensive Rapid Literacy Assessment (CRLA) and Rapid Mathematics Assessment (RMA) post assessment, but still to determine learners who are really for intervention
 - b. Camps
 - school heads consolidate the number of learners per camp (intervention, enhancement, consolidation), per learning area-English, Science, Math (ESM) and grade level, including those who would most likely fail in 1 or 2 learning areas outside the NLC and submit to the PSDSs (the link for the One Drive will be provided)
 - standard class size- Intervention=maximum of 10 learners, Consolidation=maximum of 35 learners, Enhancement=maximum of 35 learners
 - Intervention camp shall have those learners who have not achieved automaticity and are yet to grasp the foundational skills in Reading/English and Math, not met the expectations, or in extreme cases have met the expectations but are still yet to grasp the foundational skills in Reading/English and Math






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c. Volunteers

- engagement of Learning Camp Volunteers (LCV) who are DepEd incumbent teachers, non-DepEd (teacher applicants, private school teachers, LUCs/SUCs/ practitioners) who are licensed
 - consideration of specialization (Grades 1-3=training/experience in teaching Reading and Math, Grades 7-10=specialist in ESM)
 - call for application for LCV's is from March 20 to 31, 2024 and interested applicants shall express their intent using the attached templates
 - each camp in each learning area and grade level shall have 1 LCV to focus on
2. Additional updates will be given after the National Orientation on April 1 to 5, 2024. Please be guided accordingly.
