CAMPER'S QUALIFICATIONS:

Girls:

- 1. Must be a registered Girl Scout and must present her GSP ID upon registration.
- Must have at least attended a Troop/District/Provincial Camp.
- 3. Must have earned badges in the 8-Point Challenge.
- Must be able to live by the GS Promise and Law.
- 5. Must be emotionally stable and physically fit with Medical Certificate.
- Must have attended a Patrol Leaders Training Course (for Senior/cadet GS)

Adults:

- 1. Must be a duly registered Troop Leader and must present her GSP ID upon registration.
- 2. She must have directed or served as a staff in troop/district/Provincial camps.
- 3. She must be able to live by the GS Promise and Law.
- 4. She must be emotionally stable and physically fit with Medical Certificate.
- 5. She must be a Camp craft/Camper Permit/Cam
