




- 1. Please be informed of the Security Guard Refresher Training of Identified security guard/watchmen from Implementing Units (Secondary Schools) on July 1-5, 2024 at Baguio City High School.
- 2. The conference aims to:
 - Strengthen security and protection services of the school and implementation thereof are within the bounds of guidelines, policies and procedure relative to security and safety control standards. The training further aims to address the following:
 - a. Comprehensive Training: The program offers a comprehensive training curriculum that covers various competencies essential for a career in security and control systems.
 - b. Career Refresher: The training is designed to refresh the security guards and watchmen in the security industry equipping them with the necessary skills and knowledge to make a positive impact
 - c. Diverse Competencies: Participants will gain a wide range of competencies, communication skills, emergency response marksmanship skills, and defensive techniques
 - d. Workplace Security: The program focuses on effectively monitoring and securing workplace settings ensuring the safety and security of people and property.
 - e. Emergency Response: Participants will learn how to respond to potential threats and emergency situations enhancing their ability to handle critical incidents effectively.
 - f. Industry-Recognized Certification: Upon completion of the training, participants will undergo assessment for the Security Services NC certification which validates their skills and knowledge in the security field.
 - g. Protection and Safety: By re-acquiring the necessary skills participants will be able to protect people and property from harm contributing to a safer environment.
- 3. The participation of identified security guards and watchman are required to attend.
- 4. Registration fee of Php 1, 750.00 per participant from other school to cover meals and snacks. Expenses incurred in this activity shall be charged against school MOOE and/or Local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing procedures.
