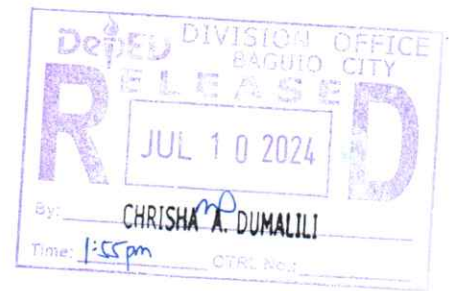

**CONDUCT OF ALS LITERACY MAPPING /ADVOCACY
AND SOCIAL MOBILIZATION**

1. Pursuant to the advocacy and social mobilization of the Alternative Learning System, ALS teachers will conduct literacy mapping, an inquiry-based strategy, in the different identified barangays in Baguio City on July 13, 20 and 27.
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. provide fair access for all students, especially those who reside in unreached and underprivileged communities to receive a comprehensive, flexible, and adequate alternative basic education outside of the formal school system, one must; and
 - b. identify the number of Out-of-School Children, Youths, and Adults (OSCYAs) who need basic literacy and education.
3. All ALS teachers from the different community learning centers and EPSAs are directed to attend the said activity.
4. All ALS teachers and EPSAs who shall attend the literacy mapping shall be given service credits/compensatory overtime credits subject to existing guidelines on the granting of service credits and COCs.
5. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is directed.
