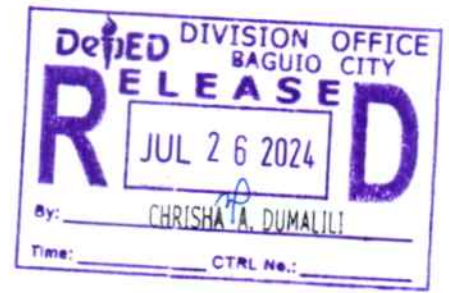

TEODORA ALONSO 2024**



1. In reference to Regional Memorandum No. 426 S. 2024: Announcement on the Conduct of Gawad Teodora Alonzo 2024, the CID - Learning Resources Management Section announces the acceptance of storybook manuscripts and screening for the said activity in the Regional Memo.
2. The objectives for harvesting and evaluation of the contextualized storybooks is for:
 - a. appreciating the role of stories and illustrated storybooks as tools in the development of reading and of learning curricular content standards;
 - b. harvest original stories that demonstrate learning competencies of the MATATAG Curriculum.
 - c. give due recognition to the skills and talents of classroom teachers, non-teaching personnel, education leaders, and learners in the production of storybook for basic education; and
 - d. contribute to the treasury of content materials for utilization as reading resources and transformation to engaging media.
3. The event is open to classroom teachers and non-teaching personnel with the interest and passion of creating stories for learners. Categories for each submission is outlined in the annexes following this memo.

4. Deadline of submission of stories shall be on **July 26, 2024**. Stories will be submitted after the date will be parked for the next period of harvesting.
 - I. Submission shall include the following:
 - a. Entry Form (duly signed by the writer and immediate supervising officer or school head)
 - b. Official Manuscript with MATATAG Learning Competencies (Don't include writer name)
 - c. Storyboard Template
 - *Submissions should be fastened with a plastic fastener.*
