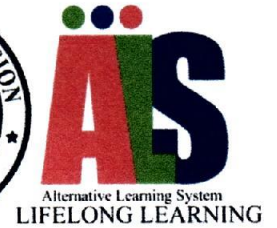

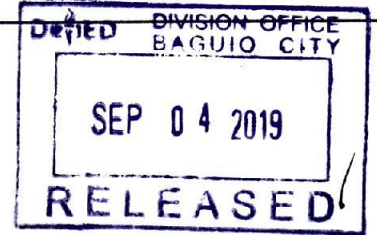

In cases of tie in Score among the top 5 nominees, the judges will break down the Literacy Cum-Livelihood Skills Training Implemented through the following:	
a. Adult Women	
1-2 skills training	4 points

c. Youths	
1-2 skills training	7 points
