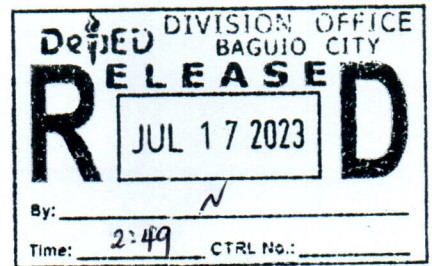

The Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) in coordination with the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD), and in partnership with the Asian Development Bank (ADB), developed the Contextualized Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs)-based Senior High School (SHS) Curriculum for Alternative Learning System (ALS). In preparation for the nationwide implementation of the ALS SHS curriculum and full implementation of the ALS K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum (BEC), the BAE will conduct the **National Training of Education Program Specialists II for ALS (EPSA) on the Provision of Technical Assistance on the Implementation of the Contextualized MELCs-based SHS Curriculum for ALS** with the following details:

This activity aims to:

- develop among EPSAs a deep understanding, familiarization, and appreciation of the Contextualized MELCs-based ALS SHS Curriculum;
- train and equip the EPSAs with the skills needed on the provision of technical assistance in lesson planning, delivery, and contextualization process of learning competencies in ALS; and
- enable the EPSAs to enhance the developed lesson plans through unpacking and contextualization of competencies, and feedbacking to demonstration teaching and simulations.

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Board and lodging and other expenses for supplies and materials will be charged to the 2023 FLO-ALS Fund. The travel and other incidental expenses will be charged to the funds comprehensively downloaded to the Regional Offices per OASALS-OM-2023-015 entitled "*Fiscal Year 2023 Alternative Learning System Funds Directly Released to the Regional Offices*", and will be reimbursed upon submission of the travel documents, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Downloading of funds to the participants' respective Schools Division Offices is highly encouraged, when deemed necessary and applicable. Program Support Fund (PSF) FY 2023 or local funds shall be utilized to augment expenses exceeding the downloaded funds.

Teacher-trainers shall observe time-on-task policy based on DepEd Order (DO) No. 9, s. 2005, "*Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance therewith.*"
