

FIGHT DENGUE: ELIMINATE BREEDING SITE TODAY

TO: ALL SDO Personnel
Others Concerned

- The Department of Health- Cordillera noted an alarming increase in the number of dengue cases in the region. About 2,122 dengue cases were logged from January 1,2024 to June 1, 2024. A total of 1137 dengue cases were recorded in Baguio in the first 26 weeks of 2024.
- 2. The report from Health Service Office, Baguio City highlights a concerning increase in dengue fever cases within the city. From January 1 to June 16, 2024, there have been 942 reported cases, which is significantly higher than the 401 cases reported during the same period in 2023.
- Local health officials are urging residents to take preventive measures to combat the spread of dengue fever.
- 4. In relation to the above-mentioned condition the following activities are to be observed:
 - a. 4 o'clock habit "OPLAN-TAOB" to be conducted every Fridays of the week at 4 o'clock in the afternoon.
 - b. Clean Up Drive along the SDO-BAGUIO premises
 - c. Larvicide Application
 - d. Information, Education and Campaign against Dengue
- 5. Your participation is highly recommended as it will increase awareness and help in the elimination of potential mosquito breeding sites.
- Immediate dissemination and strict compliance with this memorandum are directed.
