Day 6 Saturday October 12, 2024	To Pray in Silence	Contemplative prayer, also known as mental prayer, or meditation is a silent form of prayer which originates from the Christian belief that God inhabits each and every one of us, a daily meditation. Contemplative prayer is a way to get back and allow this divine encounter between our soul and God. "On that day you will realize that I am in my Father, and you are in me, and I am with you" (John 14:20) Jesus Christ is in all of us. If you want to find Him, you will have to look within yourself. It can be both a simple and a very complicated tasks; we tend to build walls that separate us from Him with your weaknesses, our wounds and pride Yet, God wants us to join Him, and let Him love us.	*Write down in your spiritual journal your reflections after the meditation. *Do a Mental Prayer. It is important to stop focusing on ourselves but to focus on God. Make ourselves completely available, to open ourselves with humility to Him who awaits us. It is important that you find inner calm to welcome God in your soul. *Start your prayer moment praying "Prayer to Saint John of the Cross" "Take me Lord, in the divine riches of your silence, fullness capable of filling everything in my soul. Silence in me what is not you, what is not your pure, lonely, peaceful presence. Impose silence on my desires, my whims, my dreams of escape, the violence of my passions, the voice of my demands, my complains. Impermeate in your silence, my nature too impatient to speak, too moved to external, noisy action. Impose also silence upon my prayer, that bit maybe moved towards thee; Bring your silence down to the depths of my being and bring this silence back to you as a tribute of love!

Day 7 Sunday October 12, 2024	Lectio Divina	Lectio Divina can help you savor the Word of God in prayer according to the Gospel. Pope Benedict XVI recommends this ancient practice that literally means "reading of God" *The prayerful reading of the, more than a reflection, is an experience of a personal and intimate encounter with God, who loves you and comes to meet you. Steps to take you to the interior with God: 1.Reading (Lectio) The biblical text must be read as many times as required until discovering the living God who is present and speaks in it. 2.Meditation (meditatia)Now comes the meditation or deepening of the text; you have to reflect widely on the passage read 3.Prayer (oratio) After having listened to God, you establish a friendly dialogue with Him, through prayer	*We invite you to perform the Lectio Divina of the Gospel of the day and to share the action or commitment that you are going to take.

4.Contemplation. After talking to God, you have to know how to enjoy
his presence in silence.
5.Action. Put the teaching of what has been read into practice in daily
life.
