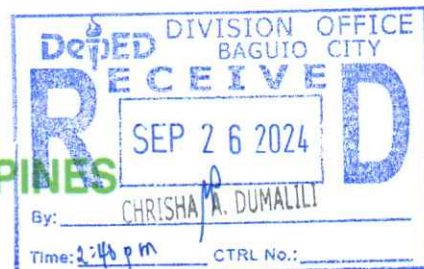

Background

During National Teachers' Month, we celebrate the gift of teachers who are mostly Troop Leaders (TL) in the GSP. They are the beloved “TITAs” who tirelessly help

Girl Scouts become the best versions of themselves. These leaders are supported by yet another “TITA” – the Council Executive (CE) who works hard to ensure that Girl Scouting continues to flourish in the field reaching more girls and young women.

They are the “TITAs” who are at the center of this year’s celebratory tribute dubbed as “TL kami ni CE” - a showcase of skills and talent in jingle composition and presentation by Troop Leaders and Council Executives from the 6 GSP Regions.

### Objectives

- To encourage the use of skills and display of talent in jingle composition and presentation of Troop Leaders and Council Executives from the 6 GSP Regions
- To recognize and appreciate the vital and inspiring roles that the Troop Leaders play in the Girl Scout Movement

### Participants

- Open to all registered Troop Leaders (TL) for Triennium 2024-2027 and Council Executives (CE) from the 96 GSP Councils. Interested participants can join in groups of three (3) or more.
- Minimum of three (3) participants per group is required (2 TL, 1 CE). There is no maximum number of TL participants per group – the more the merrier □ However, a Council Executive must be part of the group.
- The Council Executive may be part of multiple groups if there are more than one group of Troop Leaders participating from her Council.

### Mechanics

1. A group can only submit one (1) jingle composition & presentation video entry.
2. The jingle composition & presentation should pay homage to the Troop Leaders – it must revolve around the challenges and triumphs in their line of volunteer work in the GSP
3. The groups must create their own tune for the jingle composition & presentation. Using copyrighted materials is not allowed, and is a ground for disqualification.
4. The use of profane language and inappropriate gestures/actions in the jingle composition & presentation that will tarnish the image of GSP is prohibited, and will result to disqualification.
5. The groups have the freedom to use musical instruments and props that they like for the jingle composition & presentation, provided these are economically practical and not damaging to the environment.
6. Attire can be any GSP uniform, Girl Scout fun or event t-shirts, and jogging pants. Use of costume is allowed, but it must be decent and appropriate to the jingle composition & presentation.
7. The jingle composition & presentation video must not be longer than three (3) minutes in time, not bigger than 500 MB in size, and must follow the file name format below:

Title of Jingle - Region & Council

Example: Hooray for GSP Troop Leaders - NL ABRA

8. The jingle composition & presentation video must be submitted to the GSP NHQ - Training Division via the link below on or before October 1, 2024 (Thursday) at 5:00 p.m.

9. Appointed Judges will select jingle composition & presentation videos that will be featured on “TL kami ni CE” live stream on October 10, 2024 (Thursday), 5:00 p.m. on the Official GSP Facebook (FB) Page.
10. Troop Leaders and Council Executives who belong to groups whose jingle composition & presentation videos have been selected to be shown during the live stream on October 10 shall receive Certificate of Recognition and a Group Special

Prize. Others from groups of non-selected video entries will receive Certificate of Participation and a Group Consolation Prize. The GSP NHQ - Training Division will coordinate with all concerned re issuance of certificates and prizes.

11. Any complaints that may arise due to similarities or comparisons with existing jingles or songs would be the participants' accountability. They will be responsible to prove its authenticity.
12. Judges' decisions are final and irrevocable.
13. Any violation of the aforementioned mechanics will be grounds for automatic disqualification, even without prior notice to the participants.

Criteria for Judging

The jingle composition and presentation shall be judged according to the following criteria:

Content/Relevance 35 points Originality/Uniqueness 30 points  
Musicality 20 points Creativity 15 points 100 points

Please widely disseminate the above information in the field and encourage as many as possible to watch the Facebook (FB) live streaming on October 3 and October 10. The viewers will not only be inspired and entertained but may also win surprise prizes.


We also seek the full support and active participation of Council Executives and their Troop Leaders in the "TL kami ni CE" activity as this will be a great opportunity to shine and showcase their amazing skills and talent.
