#### **CRITERIA FOR RESEARCH ABSTRACT**

### 1. Clarity and Conciseness: 15 POINTS

Provides a clear and concise overview of the research purpose, methodology, key findings, and implications.

#### 2. Relevance and Significance: 25 POINTS

Clearly articulates the relevance of the research topic to the field of study and highlight its significance in addressing a gap or contributing new knowledge.

# 3. Structure and Organization: 20 POINTS

Follow a structured format, including sections on the research background, objectives, methodology, results, and conclusions.

# 4. Accuracy and Completeness: 20 POINTS

Accurately reflects the research study, including the research question, methods used, results obtained, and conclusions drawn.

## 5. Impact and Originality: 20 POINTS

Emphasizes the potential impact of the research on the field, including implications for theory, practice, policy, or future research directions.

#### CRITERIA FOR RESEARCH PRESENTER

# 1. Clarity of Research Objectives: 15 POINTS

The presenter clearly articulates the research objectives, questions, and hypotheses, providing a concise and focused overview of the study.

#### 2. Research Design and Methodology:10 POINTS

The presenter explains the research design, methodology, data collection methods, and analysis techniques used in the study, demonstrating a sound and rigorous approach to research.

### 3. Presentation Structure: 10 POINTS

The presentation is well-organized, with a clear introduction, logical flow of content, and coherent transitions between sections to engage the audience effectively.

# 4. Critical Thinking and Interpretation: 15 POINTS

The presenter engages in critical thinking, analysis, and interpretation of research findings, discussing implications, limitations, and future directions for the study.

#### 5. Response to Questions: 20 POINTS

The presenter responds to questions from the audience with clarity, confidence, and depth of knowledge, addressing inquiries, clarifications, and feedback in a professional and

# 6. Time Management: 10 POINTS

The presenter adheres to the allocated time for the presentation, maintaining a balance between content delivery and audience engagement within the designated time frame.

# 7. Overall Impact and Contribution: 20 POINTS

The research presentation makes a significant contribution to the field, advances knowledge, stimulates discussion, and leaves a lasting impact on the audience through innovative ideas, insights, and research contributions.


