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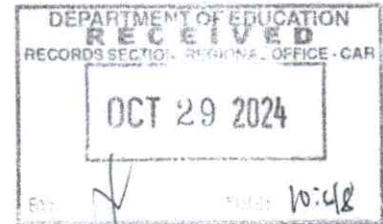

The Benguet State University—Higher Education Regional Research Center (HERRC), College of Teacher Education (CTE), Research and Extension Publications Office (REPO), and the Office of Extension Services (OES) will be conducting the **3rd Educators' Forum** on **November 7-8, 2024** at the **Everlasting Hall, Research and Extension Building, Benguet State University**.
