## 2024 Philippine Association for Language Teaching (PALT) **National Convention and Conference**

The Philippine Association for Language Teaching, Inc. (PALT) invites teaching, teaching-related, and non-teaching personnel of the Department of Education (DepEd) to participate in the 2024 PALT National Convention and Conference. The event will be held on November 29 to December 1, 2024 at Jose Rizal University, 80 Shaw Boulevard, Mandaluyong City, with the theme: "In Focus: 4 + 1 Macro Skills in the Age of Artificial Intelligence". The event was granted 14 CPD units by the Professional Regulatory Board for Professional Teachers of the Professional Regulation Commission.

At the end of the convention and conference, the participants shall be able to: (1) define key concepts relevant to the topics covered; (2) analyze visuals, images and pictures, 21st century literary texts and news articles; (3) transcode from visual-to-verbal and verbal-to-visual; and (4) share challenges and best practices on the teaching of language in the age of AI.

There will be a registration fee of ₱2,800.00 which includes access to plenary and breakout sessions, certificate of participation and attendance, and simple conference kit. Food and accommodation are not included in the registration fee.
