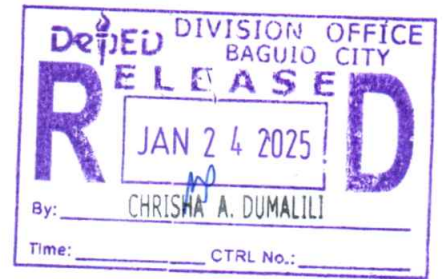

Consolation Prizes	500.00


