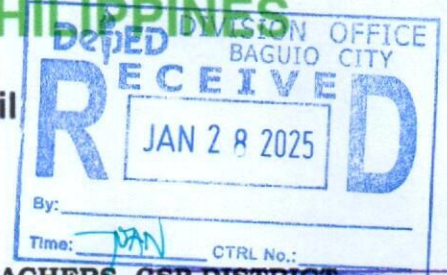

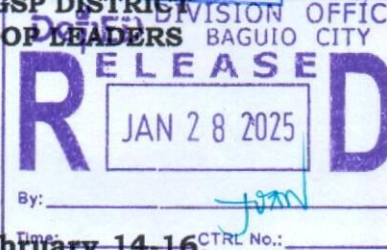

This Activity will equip our girls to become effective patrol leaders in their troop.

QUALIFICATIONS OF PARTICIPANTS

Qualification of Participants:

- Girl:** - must be registered currently as of July 2024-June 2025.
must know how to recite the GSP Promise and Law and active.
must be physically fit and alert as certified by a licensed physician.
must have her GSP Official Uniforms and paraphernalia's
(Certified GSP Authentic Official Uniforms and Paraphernalia's)
must have her GSP authentic Active Uniform
- Adults :** must be registered as Adult as of July 2024-June 2025.
must be physically fit to undergo the rigor of outdoor life.
must have undergone Outdoor Course for her to be evaluated.
Please submit your Camp Craft Evaluation Forms along with the Attachments, if not yet a Camp Craft License:
Must know how to recite her GS Promise and Law.
(Certified GSP Authentic Official Uniforms and Paraphernalia's)
must have her GSP authentic Active Uniform and GSP Official Uniform for TL.

Group:

1. A group/school must have a minimum of eight (8) girls and one (1) Chaperon.
2. Must be willing to learn and share from each other.

1. Complete Official Uniforms (Girls and Adults)
2. GSP Official Jogging Pants 2 GSP T-shirts for Girls
GSP Official Uniform and GSP Polo green & white/GSP Black Polo, GSP Jogging pants for Adults.
3. Warm night wear or pajama
4. Personal effects, toiletries and towels
5. Think jacket/Sweaters for Baguio cold weather
6. Raincoat and umbrella
7. Comfortable shoes and in-door slipper

8. Art materials, bond paper, crayons, pencils, and etc.
9. Musical instruments (optional)
10. Patrol presentation of some talent to show and share
11. Plates, spoons & fork, cups should be made out of wood, bamboos, coconut shells and other natural materials
12. Items for swapping during friendship night or 3rd day of camp.

All participants are required to submit the accomplished application and parent's consent forms for Girl Scout members, and Health Examination Form for Girl at GSP Baguio City Council Headquarters, Leonard Wood Road, Baguio City.

Service Credit will be given to the Camps Staffs and Troop Leaders who will assist their girls during the District Camp.


