

5. The first meal to be served is AM snack of January 24, 2025 and the last meal will be PM snack of January 25, 2025.







- 6. Participants who confirmed yet fail to attend the activity is required to write a justification letter (with relevant attachment) addressed to the Schools Division Superintendent.


