

2. A teacher nominee must be a classroom teacher either in public or private in both BASIC EDUCATION and HEIS.

3. The school head candidate must be a TIC, HTs, or principal with official designation.

4. For supervisors, the nominee must either be a Division Education Supervisor or Public-School Supervisor with official designation.

5. Nominees in all categories shall submit and complete the Google Form. They will be notified of their nomination through their emails.

6. Nominees will be required to submit documents related to their categories.

7. They need to attend a paper assessment and interview online.

8. Once done with the paper assessment and interview only, they can be proclaimed as 2024 INTERNATIONAL PREMIERE EXCELLENCE OUTSTANDING EDUCATORS.

9. Deadline of the Nomination will be on February 28, 2025. Interview of the nominees will be on March 01, 2025.
