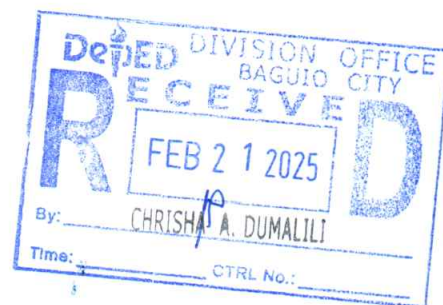

COUNCIL SCOUT YOUTH FORUM

1. We are pleased to inform you that the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Baguio City Council will conduct its **COUNCIL SCOUT YOUTH FORUM** on **Saturday, 01 March 2025** from **8:00 o'clock in the morning to 4:00 in the afternoon** at the **RCB Dome, Nanay Rosa C. Bautista Building, University of Baguio, Assumption Road Baguio City**.
2. The Scout Youth Forum aims to help Scouts acquire the experience and skills necessary to express their views and opinions constructively; provide them opportunity to discuss matters in the implementation of the Scout Program; enable them to effectively communicate their needs and aspirations on present issues and to provide young people with better understanding of the differences among people in order to help them establish effective relationships with others.
3. Hereunder are the guidelines:
 - a. Topics for Discussion - The lists of topics discussed during the Institutional/District Youth Forum will be presented for possible inclusion in the topics of the Council Scout Youth Forum.
 - b. Participation - Maximum of six (6) Scouts per school. Three (3) Official Delegates and Three (3) observers.
 - c. Qualifications:
 - Currently registered Senior Scouts
 - Must be fourteen (14) years old by December 2025
 - Must be **Grade 8 or Grade 10 student** to ensure their eligibility if elected as Scout Representatives to the Council to the Local Council Executive Board.
 - d. Organizational set-up
 - ∂ Advisory Committee Composition:
 - Chairman, Council Executive Board
 - Council Scout Executive
 - Other Scouts and Adults as necessary
 - ∂ Organizing Committee (OC)
 - Incumbent Council Scout Representatives
 - Selected Scouts who have served in higher forum levels
 - ∂ Steering Committee (SC)
 - Discussion Groups - Organized as Forum Patrols
 - e. Attire: Type A Scout Uniform
4. Observers may participate in the discussion but with no vote.
5. All delegates and observers must be at the venue at **7:30 a.m.** to answer the roll call.
