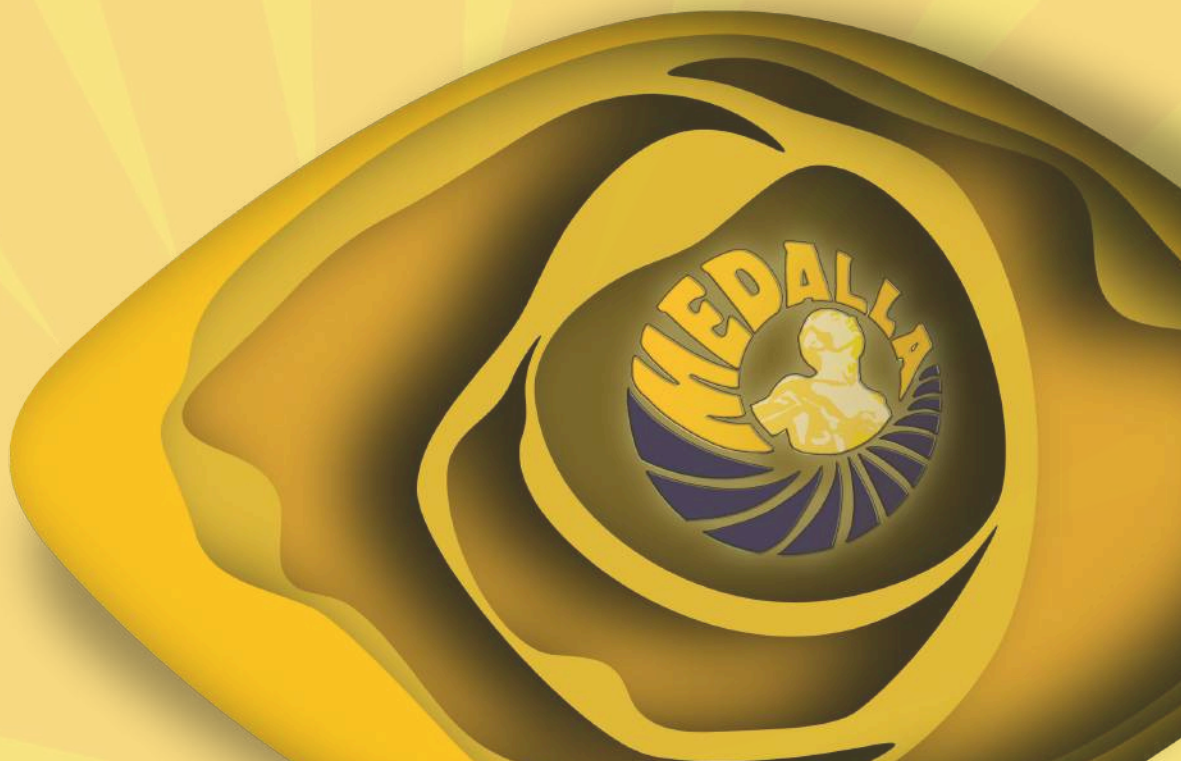

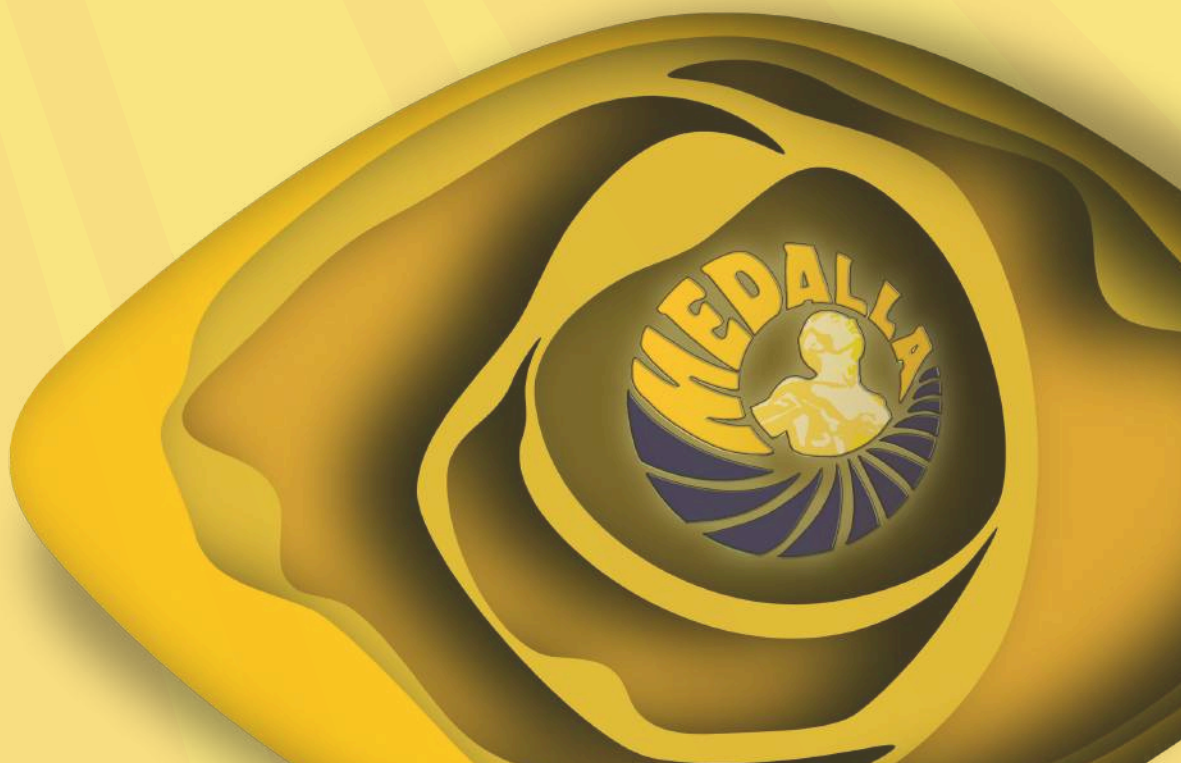

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GENERAL GUIDELINES

ORGANIZING COMMITTEES

A. THE MEDALLA COMMITTEE

The **MEDALLA Committee** is the highest policy- and decision-making body of MEDALLA. It shall be headed by the Vice President for Special Projects of UP Pre-Medical Society – Baguio and Executive for Education and Culture of UP NAMNAMA - BAGUIO, and composed by the appointed steering committee heads, and the members of the Executive Committee of each organization.

B. STEERING COMMITTEE

The Steering Committee shall oversight the progress of the project; provide advice, support and guidance to ensure the delivery of the project outputs and the achievement of the project outcomes.

PARTICIPATION

A. SCHOOLS AND CONTESTANTS

1. Any bona fide students from Junior High School and Senior High School he/ she will be representing are qualified to compete in the contest.
2. Individual certification attesting the contestants' enrollment in their respective schools or their school IDs shall be required upon registration.
3. No limit of the number of contestants per school shall be employed.
3. No limit of the number of contestants per school shall be employed. The school may send as many willing

participants and/or teams (for group competitions) to represent and compete in each category of the contests. But each participant shall only choose to join and participate in one (1) competition and shall not join other competitions aside from the chosen competition.

B. ADVISERS

1. The advisers must be a faculty member of his/her participating school supported by proper documentation (i.e faculty ID).
2. Aside from the contestants, only he/she may be the only representative of the Junior High School and/or Senior High School who can file protests or complaints to the board of judges, if appropriate.
3. The adviser shall be the only representative of the school who shall participate in decision making regarding special cases.

NOTE: *Participants may or may not choose to have an adviser upon registration and the entirety of the competition as this will not be determinant for disqualification.*

GENERAL GUIDELINES

DECISION MAKING

A. THE BOARD OF JUDGES (BOJ)

1. Each contest shall have a BOJ composed of two (2) reputable judges, academic personnel, and/or members of the organization who possess knowledge, skills, and expertise relevant for each contest.
2. The BOJ shall decide on all protests or complaints filed by any coach/adviser/contestant in all the events in the competition.
3. All decisions made by the BOJ are final and irrevocable.

LECTURE

All contestants are expected to be in the venue proper an hour before the contest itself, and fifteen (15) minutes before the starting time. The lecture series for this year will be conducted face-to-face on March 8, 2025. It is part of the opening ceremony of the event and all participants are required to attend as themes and topics of other contests are based on these lectures. Invited speakers will come from medical and public health backgrounds (physicians, medical students, public health officials, etc.).

CONTEST GUIDELINES

PUBLIC HEALTH OPINION WRITING

RULES & MECHANICS

1. The contest shall be divided into two (2) divisions:
 - a. Division 1: Junior High School Division
 - b. Division 2: Senior High School Division
2. Each division shall have 3 winners (**2 runner-ups, and 1 champion**), which will be declared after the contest.
3. The organizers shall only entertain clarifications regarding the Rules and Mechanics of the competition **BEFORE** the submission of entries. No more concerns will be addressed after the submission.
4. Changes in details (e.g., name of contestants/alternate contestants or school) after submission of online registration **shall not be entertained**.
5. All decisions are subject to the approval of the Board of Judges (BOJ) and the MEDALLA Committee and are considered **final and irrevocable**.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Participants from **Grades 7 to 10** (for Junior High School Division), and **Grades 11 to 12** (for Senior High School Division), who are bona fide students or studying in any public or private school in the Philippines are qualified to compete.
2. **Clear photos/scanned documents** of the **participant certification** that show proof of the contestant's enrollment in their respective schools **OR** their **school IDs** are required upon online registration.

GUIDELINES

1. Participants are tasked to write an opinion essay of the topic provided by the organizers based on the lecture topics during the opening ceremony.
2. The essay topics for both Junior High School and Senior High School will be given **on the spot** before the competition per se.
3. Participants are given only **two (2) hours** to write and submit the entries.
4. The medium of writing for both divisions is either in **straight English or Filipino only**.
5. Essay must be **original**, not previously published in print or online.
6. Entries must be the work of **one person only** and not be a collective work of more than one person.
7. The essay should be written in bond paper **Letter size** (21.59 cm x 27.94 cm) that will be provided by the officiating members. **An extra sheet of paper will be provided by facilitators. Any unauthorized sheet of paper is not allowed.** Essay must meet the following requirements:
 - a. Must be **relevant** to the theme and topic
 - b. Must contain a **title**
 - c. Must be within **two (2)- three (3) pages**
 - d. Must be **written neatly**

Note: Non-compliance with the format will result in disqualification of entry

PUBLIC HEALTH OPINION WRITING

DISQUALIFICATION

Participants and submitted essay will be **AUTOMATICALLY disqualified** if:

- a. Participants seek advice from their coach and/or advisers.
- b. Participants use their mobile phones during the contest proper.
- c. Submitted essays are already featured in other competitions (school-based, division, regional, national, international, etc.).
- d. Submitted essays have been previously uploaded, or published in any media form.
- e. Submitted essays are plagiarized (i.e AI generated, from another source, etc.).

SUBMISSION

1. Only one (1) entry per student.
2. Once the student has submitted, changes or corrections are prohibited.
3. The participants must submit their work on time. Failure to submit during the said deadline will face disqualification.

PUBLIC HEALTH OPINION WRITING

1. The final ranking shall be based on the **average rank** garnered by the contestants.
2. **In case of a tie**, the decision shall be based on the **first criterion** (Content).
 - a. If it fails to break the tie, the **next criterion** (Unity and Coherence) shall be used, and so on until no more ties exist.
 - b. If the tie still exists after using all the criteria, another topic shall be given. The above rules shall be used.
3. The **top three (3) scorers** shall be declared as the winners of the event.

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5. All decisions are subject to the approval of the Board of Judges (BOJ) and the MEDALLA Committee and are considered **final and irrevocable**.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Participants from **Grades 7 to 10** (for Junior High School Division), and **Grades 11 to 12** (for Senior High School Division), who are bona fide students or studying in any public or private school in the Philippines are qualified to compete.
2. Participants **MUST NOT** be a **published writer or professional journalist**.
3. **Clear photos/scanned documents** of the **participant certification** that show proof of the contestant's enrollment in their respective schools **OR** their **school IDs** are required upon online registration.

RULES & MECHANICS

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GUIDELINES

1. Participants are tasked to create a **poster on a ¼ illustration board (15" x 20")** that is expected to convey the message in line with the theme.
2. All posters must be in **portrait** orientation.
3. Participants are given only **two (2) hours** to create and submit the entries.
4. The participant must prepare their own illustration board and art materials such as colored pencils, oil pastels, paints, watercolors, and the like. All materials will be checked before the start of the contest to ensure that the illustration board is blank.
5. All elements of the poster must be original and be made from scratch. Any form of plagiarism, including but not limited to the use of reference images, is subject to disqualification.
6. The submitted poster must be a single work of original material **created solely** by the **contestant**.
7. The judges have the right to disqualify an entry at any time.

DISQUALIFICATION

Participants and submitted essay will be **AUTOMATICALLY disqualified** if:

- a. Posters that are featured or used in other competitions (school-based, division, regional, national, international, etc.).
- b. Posters that have been previously uploaded, published, or shot.
- c. Posters that bear images of public officials or any subject that may serve as a ground for endorsement.
Posters that violate a person's rights
- d. including, but not limited to, copyright or privacy.

TRADITIONAL POSTER MAKING

SUBMISSION

1. Only one (1) entry per student.
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3. The participants must submit their work on time. Failure to submit during the said deadline will face disqualification.

JUDGING CRITERIA

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IMPROMPTU SPEECH

RULES & MECHANICS

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GUIDELINES

1. The impromptu speech contest will be conducted face-to-face at University of the Philippines Baguio.
 - a. The room for the said competition will be announced on March 08, 2025 before the kickstart of all the contests.
 - b. The schedule for this contest will be from 1:30 pm to 3:30 pm. Late participants are automatically disqualified.
2. Participants should attend the opening lecture series as the topic for the contest will solely be based on it.
3. Contestants must wear business casual/ semi-formal attire/ school uniform during the event.
4. The order of performance shall be determined by a randomizer before the contest proper.
5. Each contestant will enter the room based on the generated order of performance. The remaining contestants shall wait in the waiting area/room.
 - a. Once the contestant enters the performance room, he/she is not allowed to go out anymore (i.e. use the restroom, talk to adviser/coach, etc.). The contestant will only be allowed to exit the room after his/her speech.
 - b. After the contestant's speech, he/she is not allowed to enter the waiting area/room anymore.
6. The topic shall be flashed in the Television once the contestant is settled. Each contestant shall be given only one (1) minute to prepare and organize his/her thoughts, and another five (5) minutes to deliver it.

IMPROMPTU SPEECH

7. The contestant shall not bring any of his/her gadget in the performance room. The contestant is allowed to only bring a clean paper and a pen.
8. A signal will be given to signify the last minute of their speaking time. One (1) point deduction will be given for every 30 seconds consumed beyond the allotted time.
9. The speech must be original. The speech can be delivered using the English language only.

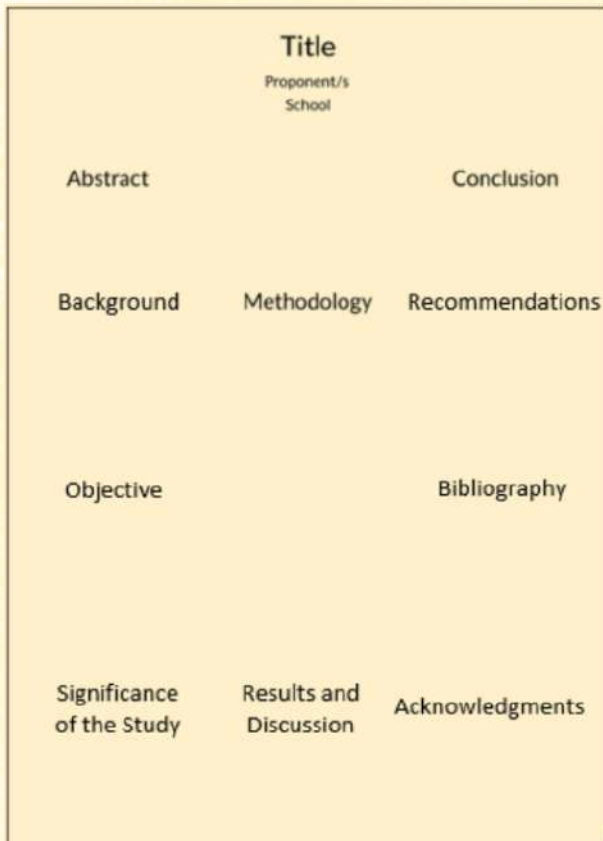

GUIDELINES

1. Participants shall form a team consisting of a **maximum of 3 members**.
2. Each team must create and present their own research. The chosen studies to be judged must be under the Life Sciences.
 - a. The research may either be Quantitative Research or Qualitative Research
3. The research paper should be prepared and available for submission.
4. Summary of the research shall be placed on a soft copy of A0 33.11 x 46.811-inch display board, which will be presented on a TV Screen.
5. The contents of the research display board shall include the following:
 - a. Title of the study
 - b. Abstract (Maximum of 250 words)
 - c. Background of the study
 - d. Objectives
 - e. Significance of the Study
 - f. Methodology
 - g. Results and Discussion
 - h. Conclusion and Recommendation
 - i. Bibliography
 - j. Acknowledgements

6. All contents of the research display board, including images, diagrams, and figures, **must fit well within the dimensions** of the display board material. The texts must also be **legible and well organized**.

7. You may create and/or edit your entries using **any editing platform** such as, but not limited to, professional editing software and applications like **illustrator, canva, publisher, and the likes**.

8. Entries must be created using the best settings of the editing platform, must be saved as a **.pdf, .jpeg or .png file, and shall not exceed 1 GB**.

9. All display boards must be in **portrait orientation**.

10. Participants are also expected to **prepare for a presentation on March 08, 2025 at the University of the Philippines Baguio**.

a. It is the participants' discretion whether to use their display board entries to present or prepare other forms of presentation such as powerpoint presentation, slideshare, etc.

b. Among the members, a **minimum of one (1) and maximum of three (3)** may present the research.

c. Each team shall only be given **15 minutes to present** their research, and an additional **5 minutes will be allotted for the questions**.

d. The room assignment will be announced on **March 08, 2025 before the kickstart of all the contests**.

11. Past research papers/works from no more than two years ago are permitted.

12. Participants must submit their display board **before the start of the contest proper**. The deadline for research display board entries is on **March 03, 2025 at 12:00 midnight**. Late submission will not be accepted and presentations will not be considered. This is inline with the posting of each entry in our Official Facebook Page as **social media engagement is part of the criteria**.

INVESTIGATORY PROJECT

DISQUALIFICATION

Participants and submitted essay will be **AUTOMATICALLY disqualified** if:

1. The whole or part of the material submitted is plagiarized and/or fabricated.
2. The research is not the students' own study.
3. The research submitted is not under or aligned to the life sciences.
4. The research was conducted or finished more than two years ago.

DISQUALIFICATION

Participants and submitted essay will be **AUTOMATICALLY disqualified** if:

1. One (1) submission for each group. One (1) group member from the team may submit their research paper and display board.

RULES & MECHANICS

1. The contest shall be divided into two (2) divisions:
 - a. Division 1: Junior High School Division
 - b. Division 2: Senior High School Division
2. Each category shall have **3 winners (2 runner-ups, and 1 champion)**, which will be declared after the contest.
3. The organizers shall only entertain clarifications regarding the Rules and Mechanics of the competition **BEFORE** the submission of entries. No more concerns will be addressed after the submission.
4. Changes in details (e.g., name of contestants/alternate contestants or school) after submission of online registration **shall not be entertained**.
5. All decisions are subject to the approval of the Board of Judges (BOJ) and the MEDALLA Committee and are considered **final and irrevocable**.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Participants from **Grades 7 to 10** (for Junior High School Division), and **Grades 11 to 12** (for Senior High School Division), who are bona fide students or studying in any public or private school in the Philippines are qualified to compete.
2. **Clear photos/scanned documents** of the **participant certification** that show proof of the contestant's enrollment in their respective schools **OR** their **school IDs** are required upon online registration.

GUIDELINES

1. The quiz bee shall be conducted **face-to-face at the University of the Philippines Baguio**. Room assignments will be announced **before** the kickstart of all contests.
2. Each group must bring their own whiteboard and whiteboard marker. If not possible, the group can use clean bond papers and a marker as an alternative.
3. The quiz bee shall compose the following categories:
 - a. **Easy Round**: two (2) point per question
 - i. Will be composed with ten (10) questions;
 - b. **Average Round**: three (3) points per question
 - i. Will be composed with ten (10) questions
 - c. **Difficult Round**: five (5) points per question
 - i. Will be composed with ten (10) questions
4. Questions will be **read by the quiz master** and will be **flashed on a TV screen**. For the easy, average, and difficult rounds, the contestants will be given a total of **20 seconds, 30 seconds and 45 seconds** respectively to think and finalize their answers.
5. Each group is advised to minimize their noise. The use of any technologies is strictly prohibited.
6. Answers shall be written on a white board or paper and should be only shown after the quiz master says "**Go**".

7. Contestants may only raise their complaints and/or clarifications **before the next question**, and shall be addressed by the Board of Judges accordingly.
 - a. **Credible and concrete sources** must be presented to back claims for errors in the questions. Online sources may be stated as well, except for Wikipedia and similar sources. (**NOTE:** The presentation of such sources does not guarantee the validity of claims, for the error may be on the part of the source.)
8. The **final ranking** shall be based on the **total combined scores** of each participant in all rounds.
9. In case of a tie, **clincher questions** will be asked to the contestants involved.
10. The **three (3) contestants** with the highest overall scores shall be awarded as the winners of the Medical Trivia Quiz Bee.

Note: All three rounds will have a total of 100 points.
