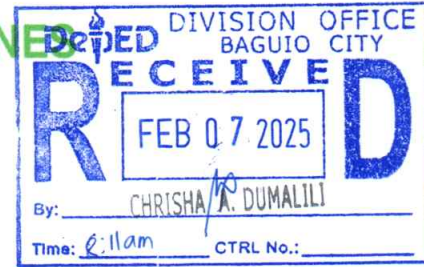

PARTICIPANTS : - at least 5 patrols per level per Council (8girls:1Adult Leader)

CAMPER'S QUALIFICATIONS:

Girls:

1. Must be a registered Girl Scout and must present her GSP ID upon registration.
2. Must have at least attended a Troop/District/Provincial Camp.
3. Must have earned badges in the 8-Point Challenge.
4. Must be able to live by the GS Promise and Law.
5. Must be emotionally stable and physically fit with Medical Certificate.
6. Must have attended a Patrol Leaders Training Course (for senior/cadet GS)

Adults:

1. Must be a duly registered Troop Leader and must present her GSP ID upon registration.
2. She must be able to live by the GS Promise and Law.
3. She must be emotionally stable and physically fit with Medical Certificate.

For Patrols:

1. Dome tents for sleeping (2 per patrol) & Fly tent for kitchen
2. Camp gadgets (table, tripod, etc.)
3. Cooking gadgets (LPG/butane is allowed) and utensils; condiments
4. Basin; container for water storage
5. Eating paraphernalia
6. Water Jug/container (750ml-1 Liter/Mineral Water available at the Trading Post for sale)
7. First Aid kit, Garbage bags for 4 days
8. Rechargeable/solar lights
9. Food supply for 4 days

Talipapa – available outside the camp

***Campers and Adult Leaders are required to be in rubber shoes/sneakers with Camp IDs at all times.**

***Extension cords are not allowed in camp.**

Confirmation as to the number of participants is on or before 21 February 2025. Accomplished forms (attached) and camp fee are to be submitted to GSP Baguio Council on or before February 28, 2025.
