**ADMINISTRATION OF THE NATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT TEST FOR
GRADE 6 FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2024-2025**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 024, s. 2025, the Schools Division of Baguio City sets the schedule for the **administration of the National Achievement Test for Grade 6 (NATG6)** for School Year 2024-2025 **on April 4, 2025**. All currently enrolled Grade 6 learners in public and private schools will take the test through a paper-pencil-based modality.
2. The NATG6 is an exit assessment designed to determine if Grade 6 learners are meeting the learning standards in the elementary curriculum. The test design measures five learning areas (English, Mathematics, Science, Filipino, and Araling Panlipunan) in a multiple-choice format.
3. All school heads, room examiners, and guidance counselors/designates will attend the **virtual orientation for the conduct of the assessment on April 1, 2025, at 8:30 in the morning** via Zoom Meeting. Meeting ID: 857 2953 7584, Passcode: jUJM8h
4. To ensure that all Grade 6 pupils are well-prepared for the National Achievement Test (NATG6 2025), the school will **conduct a dry run** to provide an opportunity for learners to become familiar with the testing format and environment, reducing anxiety and improving performance during the actual test.
