- Pursuant to DepEd Order No.001, s. 2020, titled Guidelines for NEAP Recognition of Professional Development Programs and Courses for Teachers and School Leaders, the Department of Education through the National Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) issued the DepEd Professional Development (PD) Priorities for Teachers and School Leaders.
- 2. The PD priorities, which includes Professional Programs for Master Teachers, shall support the realization of DepEd's goal of continuous upskilling and reskilling of teachers and school leaders that will result to better student learning outcome.
- 3. - 5. Conduct of the Knowledge Building Program is scheduled as follows:


