

1. In pursuit of continuous promotion for campus journalism as an essential tool in developing critical thinking, communication skills, and responsible media use among learners, District 9 will conduct a Seminar - Workshop on Basic Journalism Year 2 on July 26, 2025 at 7:30 am - 4:30 pm at Magsaysay Elementary School.
2. The objectives of this activity are:
 - a. Develop the journalistic skills of School Paper Journalists;
 - b. Engage in the editorial process by preparing and submitting polished articles for the school paper;
 - c. Work collaboratively in peer - review sessions, providing constructive feedback on each others' work to promote growth and improvement in writing and creative expression, and
 - d. Present articles and creative works in front of peers, enhancing public speaking skills and confidence in sharing their journalistic contribution.
3. Participants in the activity are the following:
 - 8 learner representatives for Filipino (1 per category: News Writing, Feature Writing, Cartooning, Sports Writing, Science Feature, Photojournalism, Copy Reading / Headline Writing, Column Writing)
 - 8 learner representatives for English (1 per category: News Writing, Feature Writing, Cartooning, Sports Writing, Science Feature, Photojournalism, Copy Reading / Headline Writing, Column Writing)
4. Service credits/Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) shall be granted to all teaching and non-teaching staff who will render services for the said activity on July 26, 2025, subject to existing DepEd and CSC rules.
