Kindly **confirm your attendance on or before July 11, 2025** through the Council Office or through the Troop Leaders GSP FB GC.


Service Credit/Compensatory Overtime Credit will be given to the Troop Leaders and Other Adult Leaders who will participate in the Troop Leaders Round Table.


