

This workshop will be facilitated by the Philippine Information Agency (PIA) – Baguio, and will cover the following topics:

- How to make a newsletter
- Basics of photojournalism (taking meaningful photos)
- Writing effective articles and reports
- Becoming a good and responsible blogger

After the training, girls are expected to:

- Develop basic journalism skills among Senior and Cadet Girl Scout by teaching them how to crate newsletters, write news and feature articles, and take effective photographs.
- Enhance communication and writing abilities to enable Girl Scouts to confidently share stories and report on activities within their troops, schools, and communities.
- Promote responsible media practice by guiding participants o how to become ethical and responsible bloggers and content creators.
- Encourage creativity and critical thinking through hands-on activities in news writing, photojournalism, and blogging.
- Empower Girl Scouts as young leaders and storytellers who can inspire others and advocate for positive change through responsible journalism.

QUALIFICATIONS OF PARTICIPANTS

1. All participants must be physically fit and able to participate in all activities.


