

In celebration of the Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP) 85th Anniversary, and as part of the **Girl Scout Week 2025**, the GSP will hold the **Long Green Line** and a series of interactive activities on **Sunday, September 21, 2025, 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 n.n. at the Rizal Park, Manila.**

Guided by the theme, ***“Once a Girl Scout Always a Girl Scout,”*** this event aims to highlight the legacy of the Movement in shaping generations of empowered girls and women. Through a variety of engaging booths, performances and contests, the activities are designed to strengthen our commitment to the Girl Scout Promise and Law, foster creativity and unity, and showcase the vitality and relevance of Girl Scouting in today’s society.

The symbolic Long Green Line – formed by the Girl Scouts, will serve as a powerful visual representation of the enduring spirit, continuity, and a collective strength of the Movement across generations.

All Girl Scouts, Troop Leaders, Volunteers, and Professional staff all over the country are enjoined to participate in the Long Green Line. The 16 Councils under Northern Luzon Region are expected to send at least 100 participants to Rizal Park, Manila:



Kindly submit the list of participants to the GSP Baguio City Council not later than **August 30, 2025**. This will allow the GSP National Headquarters prepare necessary event materials such as activity cards, badges, and certificates.

No participation fee shall be collected; however, it is highly encouraged for all participants, activity facilitators, volunteers and staff to wear the limited-edition GSP 1940 Fun Shirt. This will be available at the GSP Shop by mid-August.


