

**REVISED GUIDELINES ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF
SCHOOL-BASED IMMUNIZATION (SBI)**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chief, SGOD and CID
All Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
School Health Personnel
All Others Concerned

- 1. The Department of Health (DOH)**, in collaboration with the **Department of Education (DepEd)**, will implement the annual **School-Based Immunization (SBI)** campaign in all target schools nationwide. This initiative aims to protect school aged children against vaccine-preventable diseases (VPDs) such as measles, rubella, tetanus, diphtheria, and human papillomavirus (HPV).
- In line with this, the DOH - Office of the Secretary has issued Department Memorandum No. 2025-0318, titled "Revised Guidelines on the Implementation of School-Based Immunization", dated July 10, 2025. This issuance serves as the official technical reference to guide and strengthen the implementation of SBI services.
- The full resumption of face-to-face classes exposes school learners to a higher risk of contracting vaccine-preventable diseases (VPDs). Therefore, it is imperative to implement the School Based Immunization (SBI) Program.
- Parental consent must be secured prior to the conduct of the activity. The school nurse-in-charge shall issue notification letters and consent forms to parents or guardians.
- Schools within the LGU catchment area shall endorse the list of enrolled **Grade 1, Grade 7, and female Grade 4 learners** for the current school year to the local barangay health center.
- The immunization schedule for **high school students** is set for **September 2025**, while **elementary students** will be scheduled in **October 2025**, due to the limited supply of HPV vaccines from the Health Services Office.
- School officials are enjoined to provide full support in the conduct of the activity. School Health personnel are expected to closely coordinate with the Health Services Office in the conduct of vaccination activities.
- Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
