

 - e. How many external tutors are in the ARAL?
 - f. Is there pull-out session, how many and what time?
 - g. What time is ARAL conducted?
 - h. What are the findings in the Multi-Factored Assessment Tool (MFAT) in Grade 1?
 - i. Are teachers trained in the ARAL materials?
 - j. Are there external partners to help in ARAL-food, tutorial, etc.?
 - k. How many volunteers did we engage? (SGOD)
