
CONTEST MECHANICS

2. **MEDIUM:** 3D sculpture using corrugated cardboard boxes (Cardboard material will be provided by Mika'san Sweetshop). Adhesives will be at the participant's own expense. Note: No paint or coloring materials allowed. **DIMENSIONS:** Freestanding sculptures only, minimum size 2 ft. x 3 ft. and maximum size 2 ft. x 4 ft.
3. **CONTEST THEME:** "*Indigenous Culture of the Cordilleras*". The contest aims to showcase the local culture through the arts while advocating environmental awareness through recycling.
