



1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines will conduct the **68th Jamboree-On-The-Air (JOTA) and 29th Jamboree-On-The-Internet (JOTI)** which will be held on **October 17-19, 2025** at **Calaca Central School, Calaca City, Batangas**.
2. The official amateur radio club of the BSP is **DX1BSP** per approved National Executive Board Resolution No. 53-2017, series of 2017. DX1BSP shall be responsible for the conduct of the JOTA and JOTI.

The jamboree is fun oriented with "Jamboree on the Air" facilitated via High Frequencies (HF) and Digital Voice Radio Communication as a Unique Element of the weekend.
